You will construct either View A or View B.

The sample jacket is made of rip-stop and lined with cotton flannel. This class will not address using a lining.

Preparation to be completed before class:

- \circ $\;$ Have your pattern cut into individual pattern pieces and ironed.
- I highly recommend you write your name on each pattern piece, the instruction pages and the envelope.
- If you feel comfortable with pattern layout on your fabric please continue; there are 19 pattern pieces, lots of cutting and marking! On page 5 and 6 of the instruction booklet there are guidelines for fabric layout. PAY ATTENTION TO WHETHER THE PIECE IS CUT ON A SINGLE LAYER OR DOUBLED.
- On pages 5 and 6 there are specific instructions how to cut the interfacing.

Prepare your fabric: Prewash, dry and iron your fabric.

The supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine
- Serger with thread matching your fabric
 - You may also use a flat felled or French seam construction.
- Thread to match your fabric

- Separating zipper. **Zipperstop.com** is an excellent source for a separating zipper.
- Snaps: I have a snap press you may use for applying snaps to your jacket.
 Goldstartool.com offers snaps, see: Standard Spring Snaps ½"; I have the dies required to set the snaps. I have a supply of gold tone snaps; snaps are available in other colors.
- Additional Supplies: refer to page 1 of instruction booklet for supplies as listed by the pattern company.
- Cutting scissors*
- Trimming scissors*
- Tape measure*: we will use this to position the pattern pieces on the grainline. Please do not rely on someone else having a tape measure.
- Presser feet I used during construction were:
 - Straight stitch foot*
 - Zipper foot*
 - Edge stitching foot*
- Marking pencils appropriate for your fabric*
- Seam gauge*
- Seam ripper*

I am looking forward to working with you all; we are in a class to teach one another and to learn from one another. Let's have some fun! If you have any questions or concerns, please call me, or email me.
