## THREAD PAINTING SUPPLY LIST

Thread painting is an embroidery technique that can add beauty and dimension to fabric. The secret is “stabilization!” We will look at different methods including hoops, commercial stabilizers, heavy fabric (like canvas), and quilts.

Thread painting is basically free motion sewing to an extreme. You can change the colors of the fabric. Colors can be blended together. The entire fabric may be covered in stitching!

### FABRIC

6 inch square of heavy fabric such as canvas upholstery fabric ***without any rubberized backing***  
Any interfacing or stabilizers

### NOTIONS & TOOLS

\*Thread in many colors

\*Thread snips

Simple picture that you will be using as a pattern (coloring books are great resources)

Pencil

Reading glasses if you need them

### MACHINES & ACCESSORIES

\*Sewing machine with power cord (& foot control if needed) in good working condition

\*Free motion foot

\*Sewing machine needles size 14 (Red Tips)

Preloaded bobbins in darks and lights (2 each)

### BEFORE YOU COME TO CLASS

Trace your picture onto your 6 inch fabric block. Or if you prefer you can just do the practice exercises.

Ann will have available several supplies that you may use.

Iron-on interfacing

Stabilizers

Fabric markers

Books about thread painting

Batting
