For Tribes, Good Fire a Key to Restoring Nature and People



"Over several days in early October, about 80 acres (32.4 hectares) on the Yurok reservation [were] set aflame. The burning was monitored by crews wearing protective helmets and clothing — firefighting gear and water trucks ready.

They were part of a program that teaches Yurok and other tribes the ancient skills of treating land with fire. Such an act could have meant jail a century ago. But state and federal agencies that long banned "cultural burns" in the U.S. West are coming to terms with them — and even collaborating — as the wildfire crisis worsens."




