

Don't let love get lost in translation— all about the 5 love languages



From the **Optimist Daily**: "It's important to show the people you love how much you truly care—but how can you be sure that your expressions of affection are landing the way you want them to? The key to ensuring that your love (romantic, familial, or friendly) isn't being lost in translation, is to learn their love languages. What are the love languages?

Gary Chapman, Ph.D., developed the concept of the five love languages, which are as follows: words of affirmation, quality time, receiving gifts, acts of service, and physical touch. The idea behind the love languages is that everyone has a preferred way of communicating and receiving love and to help us navigate these distinct styles, Chapman authored the book *The 5 Love Languages: The Secret to Love That Lasts*, which was informed by his experience in marriage counseling and linguistics.

'We all may relate to most of theselanguages, but each of us has one that speaks to us the most,' says marriage and family therapist Sunny Motamedi, Psy.D. 'Discovering you and your partner's primary love language and speaking that language regularly may [create] a better understanding of each other's needs and support each other's growth.'"
