

# YARN BOWLS SUPPLY LIST

## YARN & THREAD

Several varieties, enough to make a pencil sized group when twisted together (usually 6-8 depending on thickness)—approximately 15 yards total

- Any fiber--cotton, wool, acrylic, silk, metallic thread, etc.
- Pearl cotton, metallic, eyelash, little "flags," etc.
- AVOID "bulky" yarns and yarns described as "thick and thin"—they will not fit easily under the beading foot
- Narrow strips of fabric (torn or cut) can also be used, bowl will be stiffer—save for a later project
- There will be an assortment of yarns available at class to enhance your selections if needed

## **SEWING & BOBBIN THREAD**

- \*Normal sewing thread in a color that works with your yarn colors (black is always good)
- \*The bobbin thread will show but does not need to match the top thread—it's a good place to use metallic thread that doesn't sew nicely

## **NOTIONS & TOOLS**

- \*Thread scissors or snips
- \*Stiletto or seam ripper
- \*Any other favorite sewing tools

Reading glasses if you need them

# **MACHINES & ACCESSORIES**

- \*Sewing machine with a zig-zag stitch plus power cord & foot control in good working order
- \*Size 14 or 16 needles (plus extras)
- \*Beading foot, large—because we cannot guarantee we will have the correct foot in stock on class day, make sure that you purchase or special order it at least two weeks in advance
- \*Open toe foot
- \*Available for purchase from Sewing Center of Santa Fe
