



CHANGING SEASONS: FALL SUPPLY LIST

*Changing Seasons: Fall pattern and designs

FABRIC (for the entire project)

Applique: 14 fat quarters for backgrounds, various scraps for the applique.

Flying Geese: fat quarter for background and 6 scraps for geese

Log Cabin: fat 1/8ths each for centers, 3 lights and 3 darks

Witch/Fall border corners: Scraps

Lattice: 3/4 yd

Inner border: 1/2 yd

Checkerboard border: 1/4 yd each of two colors

Outer border: 1/2 yd

Binding: 1/4 yd

*Ultra Clean & Tear (or Medium Weight Tear Away in black under dark fabrics)

*Fusible Tear Away

*Heat & Bond or other applique stabilizer

NOTIONS & TOOLS

*50 weight piecing thread

*40 weight embroidery threads

*Bobbin weight thread

*Fabric marker

*Spray starch

*Pins

*Rotary cutter and ruler

*Scissors

*Seam ripper

Painter's tape

Several plastic bags for sorting fabrics

*Hand sewing needles

Reading glasses if you need them

Additional notions

- DMC embroidery floss for witch's and scarecrow's hair, plus turkey)
- Button for doorknob (optional)

MACHINES & ACCESSORIES

*Sewing machine with power cord and foot control if needed

*Size 11 needles

*"A" foot

First Class: LOG CABIN (can fussy cut the center square with a novelty fabric, like a spider or leaf), Flying geese, and checkerboard

You will NOT need your embroidery machine for the first month's session.

Please also bring

- Any other fabrics that you might have for the other backgrounds and appliques
- Painter's tape or sticky notes
- Pins
- Plastic bags
- Basic supplies for sewing, cutting, pinning, marking.

We'll also discuss different methods on how to print, draw or copy, fuse, and cut out the applique shapes provided in the pattern.
