## INTRODUCTION TO MACHINE EMBROIDERY SUPPLY LIST

This is an all day class, please come prepared with:

- Lunch (and any snacks you may need for energy)
- Embroidery Machine\*
- Power Cord\*
- Pencil/Pen and Paper for note taking
- Machine Manual
- P foot—embroidery foot (not darning foot P-2)\*
  
- Hoop: SQ14, SQ14a, SQ14b—depending on your machine (Older machines "ST" or "A")\*
- The plastic grid for the Hoop\*
- New USB Memory Stick (Older machines: ATA Card and Adaptor)\*
  
- Scissors to cut thread\*
- Tweezers\*
- Fine Point Removable marking pen—water erase, air erase, or Frixion\*
  
- TearAway Stabilizer (Medium Weight)\*
- 3 or 4 colors of 40wt polyester or rayon embroidery thread\* (think floral, include a green)
- Bobbin filled with white Bobbin thread (60wt.)\*
- You can bring your laptop, power cord and mouse if you need further help with design transfer.

We will provide a nice hand towel for you to embroider your design on.

***If time allows we will delve further into trouble shooting your first efforts at Machine Embroidery.***

If you have an object that you wish to embroider on, but don't know what stabilizer to use or how to hoop it, bring it along for discussion.

If you have embroidered something that did not turn out as nice as you had hoped, bring it along for troubleshooting.
