*Morning Melody Bargello pattern

This is a Bargello Quilt made in strips. The center measures 105 inches long with the 18 fabrics without borders. If you want to put borders on your quilt you may want to elect to use only 16 fabrics. I will be happy to meet with you to help you with your fabric choices prior to class.

FABRIC

You will need 9 strips 2 ½ inches wide cut width of fabric (WOF) leaving the selvages on for a Queen Size quilt. See pattern for number of strips for a King or Lap size quilt. You may use Jelly rolls if you have 9 strips of each fabric.

NOTIONS & TOOLS

- *Thread to match your fabrics
- *Rotary cutter
- *Seam ripper
- * Thread snips
- *Anything else you use regularly when you sew
- Reading glasses if you need them

MACHINES & ACCESSORIES

- *Sewing machine in good working condition with power cord and foot control
- *New size 11 needles in your machine plus extras
- *1/4" foot

BEFORE THE FIRST CLASS

Cut out all your strips for the size of quilt you are making, leaving on the selvages. Number your fabric strips with blue painters tape from 1 to 18.

For the 1st class we will be sewing the strips together. For the 2nd class we will cut tubes into rows and separate the rows at the proper location to make the up and down design. We will also start sewing the rows together.
