

4 or 9 Month Trial

- The trial is a one-time rental that cannot be repeated
- Refunds are not available for the return of your instrument prior to the end of your trial period

Options After Your 4 or 9 Month Trial Ends

- Purchase your rental instrument
- Continue renting to own your instrument on a monthly basis
- Return your instrument

Purchasing Your Rental Instrument

- 100% of your payments are credited toward the purchase of the instrument you are renting
- 40% discount off the balance, on the instrument you are renting, when you pay off your account

String Instrument Size Exchanges

- 100% of your payments will apply if you exchange instruments for a different size

Other Instrument Exchanges

- Exchanges can be made for a \$20.00 fee
- 50% of your payments will apply to your exchanged instrument

Returns

- You are under no obligation, beyond the initial trial, and can return your instrument at any time
- Once returned, your contract is canceled, and you forfeit all payment credits
- Contact Hunterdon Music if you wish to return your instrument
- Do not return your instrument to the student's school without authorization from Hunterdon Music
- You are responsible for payments until Hunterdon Music retains physical possession of the instrument
- Return all original accessories to avoid being billed for their replacement

Warranty

- Repairs not caused by negligence are covered at no additional charge during the warranty period
- Your warranty applies during the entire rental period and for 90 days from the date of purchase
- Not covered
 - Damage due to negligence: dents, cracks etc.
 - Disposable items: reeds, strings, grease and oil etc.
 - Accessories: mouthpieces, straps etc.
 - Finish deterioration
 - Lost or stolen instruments
- All repairs must be performed by Hunterdon Music

Payments

- If you chose "Charge my credit card"
 - Your credit card will be billed monthly for as long as you continue to rent your instrument
 - If your credit card information changes, contact Hunterdon Music to update your information
 - Accounts unable to be charged within 15 days of the payment due date are considered past due
- If you chose "Send me a payment book, and I will mail in payments"
 - You will receive a coupon book for mailing your monthly payments
 - Accounts 15 days past the payment due date are considered past due
 - There is a \$40.00 returned check fee
 - Do not postdate checks - checks will be deposited when received

Past Due Accounts

- Accounts 15 days past due will incur a late fee of \$8.00 each month the account is past due
- Accounts 60 days past due are subject to the following
 - A collection fee of 30% of the outstanding amount plus all late fees and court costs
 - Picking up the instrument without prior notice
 - Cancellation of any discount option

If bankruptcy is filed, the instrument must be returned to Hunterdon Music immediately

This is not a sales contract. The musical instrument remains the sole property of Hunterdon Music until full payment is received.
