Marcus Fabrics Prairie Dry Goods Yardage Quilt

Finished quilt size: 85" x 85"

Finished block size: 2 ½" x 5" (sashing blocks); 5" x 5" (patch blocks)

Backing: 93" x 93" (2 5/8y of 108" wide fabric)

Binding: 3/4y of R171651D-Black, cut (11) 2 1/4" x WOF strips, piece to make a binding strip

Fabric A R171649D-Cream		2 3/4y	a. Sashing blocks (33) 1 ¾ x WOF strips. Subcut (720) 1 ¾ x 1 ¾ squares. b. Inner border (8) 3 ¾ x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3 ¾ x 73 and (2) 3 ¾ x 79 ½ strips.
Fabric B R171646D-Blue		3 3/8y	a. Sashing blocks (14) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (180) 3" x 5 ½" rectangles. b. Outer border (9) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3 ½" x 79 ½" and (2) 3 ½" x 85 ½" strips.
Fabric C R171659D-Tan		3/4y	a. Cornerstones (7) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (81) 3" x 3" squares.
Fabric D R171648D-Blue Fabric F R171649D-Yellow Fabric H R171652D- Cheddar	Fabric E R171649D-Lilac Fabric G R171650D-Purple Fabric I R171652D-Gold	1/4y	a. Patch blocks (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (5) 5 ½" x 5 ½" squares.



Constructing sashing blocks


- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of
- (1) 3" x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with (3) additional 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric A squares at the remaining corners of the same Fabric C rectangle.



Make a total of (180) blocks.

Quilt top assembly

- 1. **Pieced rows.** Arrange sew together (10) 5 ½" x 5 ½" assorted print patch blocks, alternating with (9) sashing blocks to make a pieced row. Make a total of (10) pieced rows.
- 2. **Pieced sashing rows.** Arrange and sew together (10) sashing blocks, alternating with (9) 3" x 3" Fabric C squares, to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of (9) pieced sashing row.
- 3. **Quilt center.** Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows, to complete quilt center.



Note: Border strips are sewn short strips first to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by longer strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

- 4. Inner border. Fabric A.
- (2) 3 ³/₄" x 73" strips, then (2) 3 ³/₄" x 79 ¹/₂" strips.
- 5. Outer border. Fabric B.
- (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 79 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, then (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 85 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to complete quilt top.



Finishing

- 1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
- 2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to complete the guilt.
