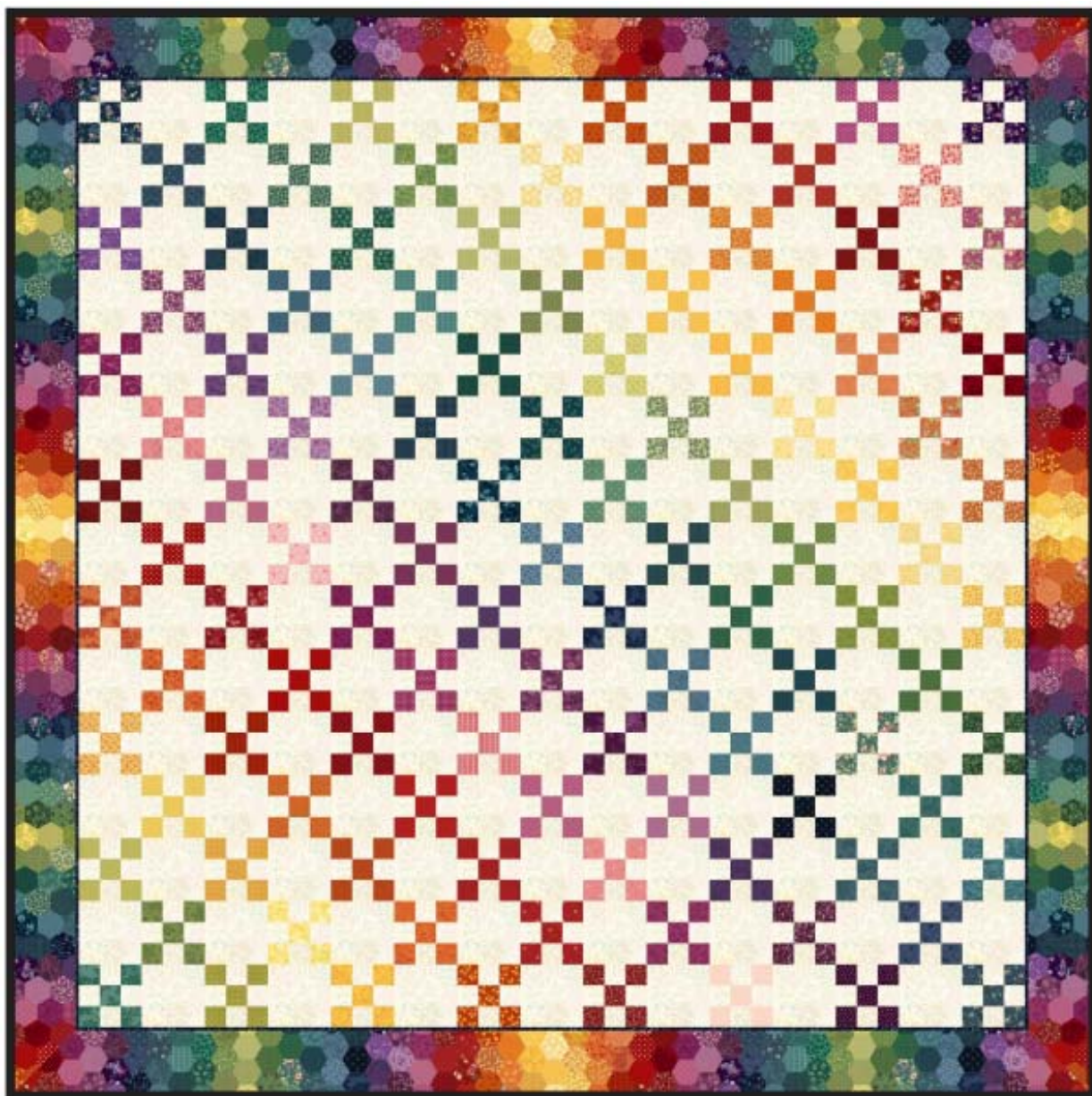


Patrick's Promise

Sweet Sixteen

I love a simple nine patch, and I love the scrappy look. Finally, Marcus has created Patrick's Promise for you to obtain that scrappy look without having to purchase a huge amount of fabric. Enjoy!

Supplies

From each color bolt of Patrick's Promise (two bolts of each color: red, orange, yellow, green, teal, blue, purple and pink):

¼ Yard

OR

From EACH of sixteen prints in EACH colorway, (red, orange, yellow, green, teal, blue, purple and pink):

(1) 5 ¼" x 9" rectangle of fabric,

¾ yard strip-it in your choice of color for the inner border and binding (sample made with ¼ yard of Patrick's Promise color Navy),

3 ¼ Yards low volume background fabrics (all the same or a combination— it's up to you!),

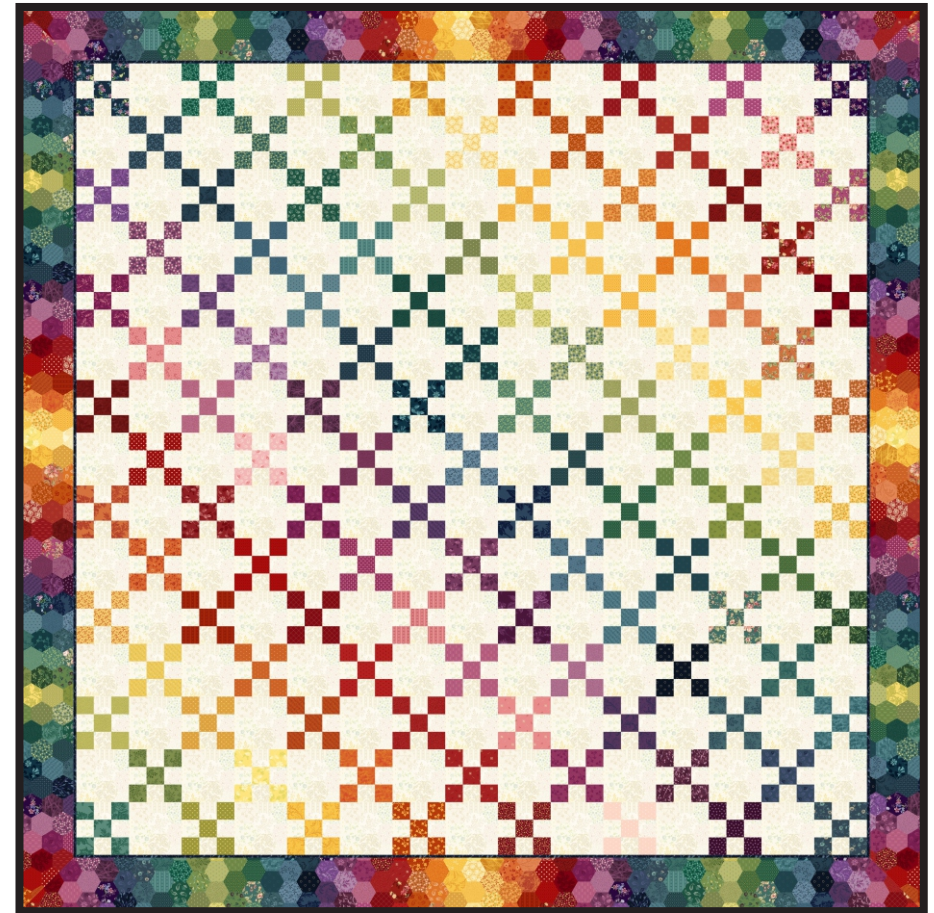
1 ¼ Yards Hexi rainbow print for the outer border, and

5 Yards backing fabric



Green Light Quilts Presents

Quilt size is 77" x 77"

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Sweet Sixteen

Please read all instructions before you begin.

Seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise stated.

Press the seams in the direction of the arrows.

Cutting:

From the low volume background fabric(s), cut:

(112) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, and

(452) 2" squares.

From Each of (16) different fabrics in red, orange, yellow, green, teal, blue, violet and pink cut:

(5) 2" squares.

From the inner border fabric, cut:

(2) $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $67\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, and

(2) $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $68\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

From the outer border fabric, cut:

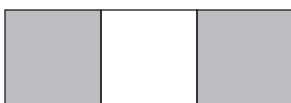
(2) 5" x $68\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, and

(2) 5" x $77\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Sew the Nine Patch Blocks:

For each nine-patch block you will need (5) 2" squares of a rainbow color and (4) 2" squares of background.

Sew a color 2" square to each side of a 2" background square, as shown:



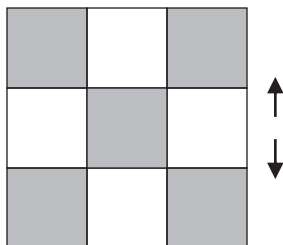
Rectangle A measures 2" x 5". Make (2) just like this for each nine patch block.

Sew a background 2" square to each side of a color 2" square, as shown:



Rectangle B measures 2" x 5". Make (1) just like this for each nine-patch block.

Sew a long side of each rectangle A units to each long side of rectangle B, as shown:



Nine-Patch measures 5" square.

The total number of nine-

patches you will need:

15 blue,
14 violet,
14 pink,
14 red,
14 orange,
14 yellow,
14 green, and
14 teal.

Please refer to the diagram on the cover for block placement.

Sew together the nine-patch blocks, alternating a nine-patch with a 5" background square. Press the seams towards the background squares.

Sew the rows together, and press the seams in the direction of your choice.

Sew a $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $67\frac{1}{2}$ " navy inner border rectangle to each side of the quilt, and press towards the inner border.

Sew a $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $68\frac{1}{2}$ " navy inner border rectangle to the top and bottom of the quilt and press towards the inner border.

Sew a 5" x $68\frac{1}{2}$ " outer border rectangle to each side of the quilt center, and press the seam towards the outer border.

Finally, sew a 5" x $77\frac{1}{2}$ " outer border rectangle to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
