## On A Roll!!

Do you love the scrappy look but either lack the stash or desire to coordinate fabrics? Look no further! Patrick's Promise is a fun and flirty fabric line that boasts over 160 different prints! Combine all of the prints and the convenience of a strip roll and you will find yourself On A Roll!! Enjoy!

### Supplies:

(1) Patrick's Promise 2 ½" strip rolls,

2 ½ Yards Vanilla Honeycomb R162112D

⅔ Yard R162105D Blue for binding, and

4 Yards backing R162111D Multi hexagon  
or 2 yards 108" backing

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## On A Roll!!



Quilt size is 56" x 63"

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Please read all instructions before you begin.

All seams are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise stated.

Press the seams in the direction of the arrows.

## Cutting

For EACH nine patch, cut:

Separate the jelly roll and use each strip once for the nine patch step. There will be two different strips for each color grouping. (Put aside the light blue and backgrounds.)

From EACH color print, cut:

(1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" rectangle.  
From this rectangle, cut (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square and (4)  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.

You will need a total of:

(13) Violet sets,  
(13) Pink sets,  
(12) Red sets,  
(12) Orange sets,  
(12) Yellow sets,  
(12) Green sets,  
(12) Teal sets, and  
(12) Dark blue sets.

For the piano key border, cut:

From the second group of strips, cut each color print into (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" rectangle. (Set aside the low volume background and light blue strips.)  
You will need a total of:

(14) Violet,  
(14) Pink,  
(14) Red,  
(12) Orange,  
(14) Yellow,  
(14) Green,  
(14) Teal, and  
(14) Dark blue.

From the Vanilla background, cut:

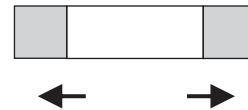
(10) 4" x WOF strips.  
From these strips, cut:  
(97) 4" squares,  
(13)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.  
From these strips, cut:  
(392)  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles,  
(6)  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips.  
Sew the short ends of these strips together and cut out:  
(2)  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $47\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, and

(2)  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 53" rectangles.

## Sew the 9-patches:

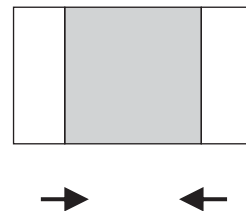
Here are the basic sewing instructions for creating a 9-patch:

From the same print of fabric, sew a  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " square of fabric to each sort end of a  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " vanilla rectangle, as shown:



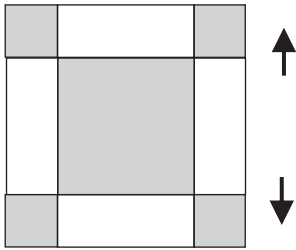
Rectangle A measures  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4". Make (2) for each 9-patch block.

Sew the long side of a  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " vanilla background rectangle to each side of a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " print fabric square, as shown:



Rectangle B measures  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4". Make (1) for every 9-patch block.

Sew the long side of a rectangle A to each long side of a rectangle B, as shown:



9-patch measures 4" square. Please refer to the cutting requirements for the total number of 9-patches from each color.

### **Sew together the piano keys:**

Sew the long sides of the piano keys together as follows and press the seams in the direction of your choice:

From the violets, pinks, reds, yellows, greens, teals, and dark blues: Sew two groups of seven 2 ½" x 5" rectangles, and

From the oranges, sew two groups of six 2 ½" x 5" rectangles together.

Sew the piano key borders together as follows:

Sew a yellow group, green group, teal group and blue (in that order) together, and press the seams in the direction of your choice. Upper and lower outer border will measure 5" x 56 ½" rectangle. Make (2) just like this.

Likewise, sew a violet group, pink group, red group and orange group together (in that order) and press the seams in the direction of your choice. Side borders will measure 5" x 54 ½". Make (2) just like this.

### **Assemble the quilt center:**

Using the diagram on the cover as a guide, sew the 9-patches and vanilla background squares together in rows. Press the seams toward the background squares. Sew the rows together and press the seams in the direction of your choice. The quilt center will measure 46" x 53".

### **Attach inner border:**

Sew the long side of a 1 ¼" x 53" vanilla inner border rectangle to each long side of the quilt. Press the seams toward the inner border.

Sew the long side of a 1 ¼" x 47 ½" vanilla inner border rectangle to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press the seams toward the inner borders. Quilt center now measures 47 ½" x 54 ½".

### **Attach outer border:**

Use the diagram on the cover for reference.

Sew the long side of the orange/red/pink/violet piano key border to each side of the quilt center, and press the seam towards the quilt center. Be sure that the colors are going in the correct direction.

Sew the long side of the yellow/green/teal/blue piano key border to the top and bottom of the quilt center, and press the seams toward the quilt center. Again, be sure that the colors are in the proper order.

The quilt measures 56 ½" x 63 ½".

Baste, quilt, bind and ENJOY!
