

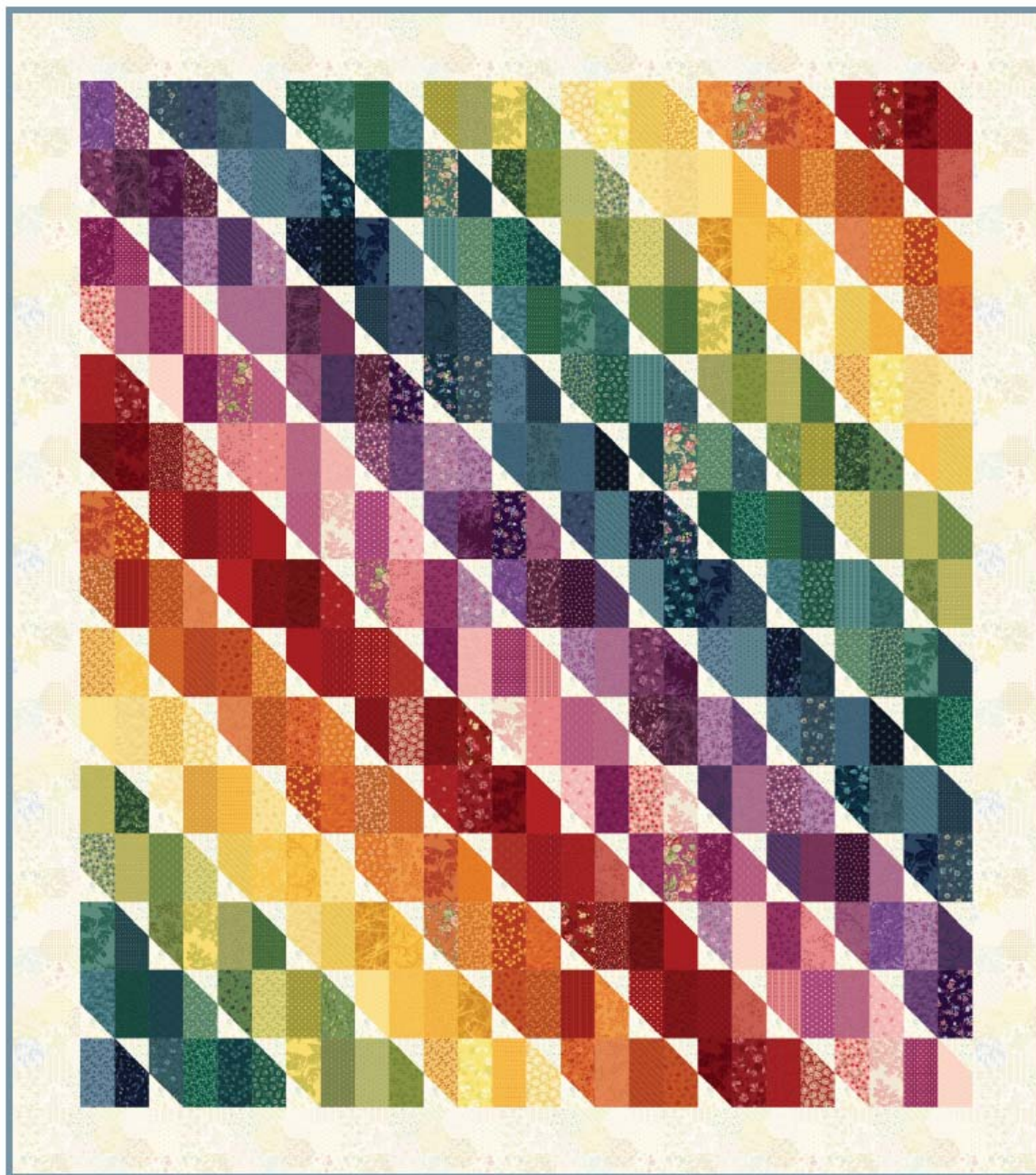

Ribbons and Rainbows

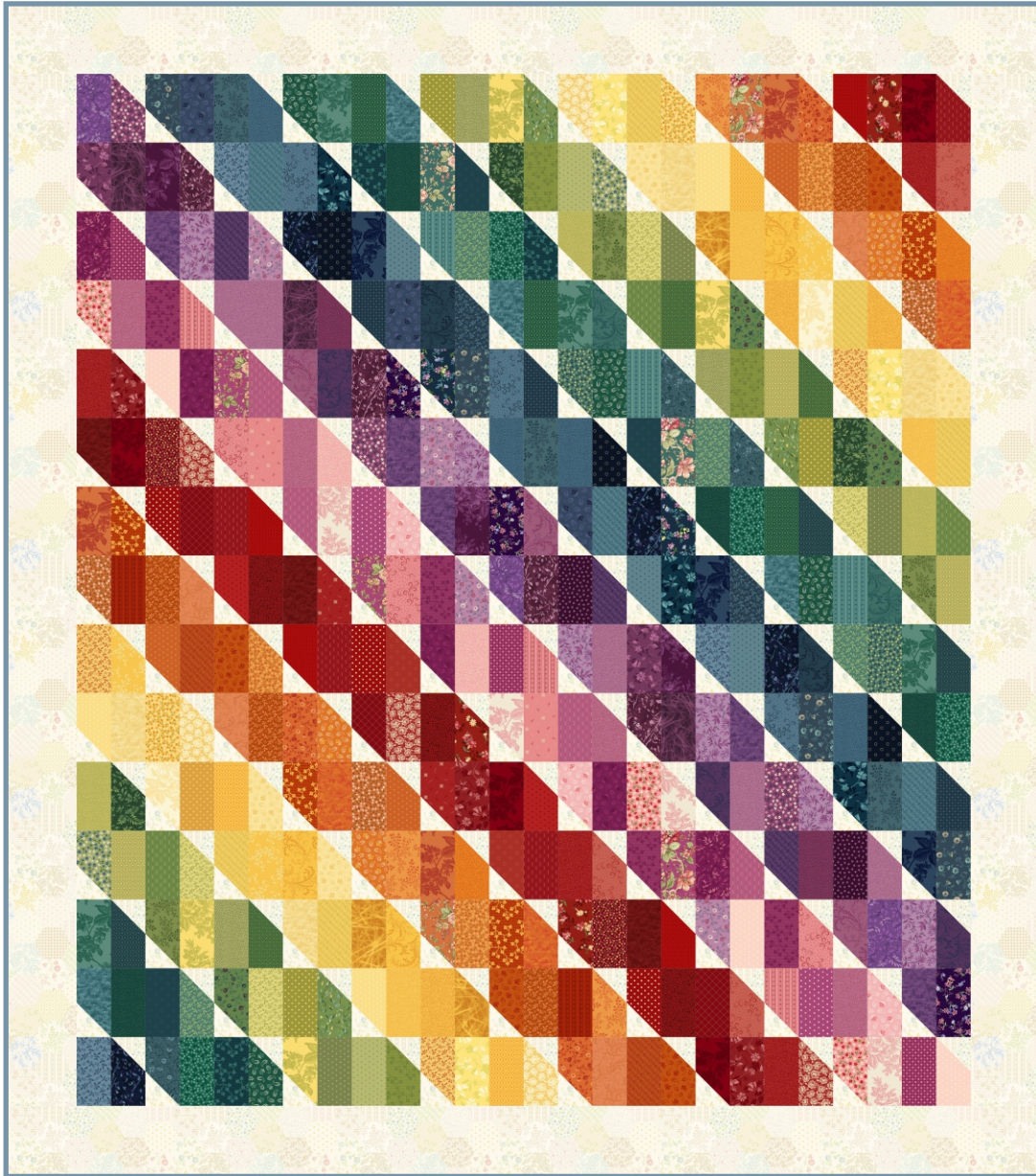


Quilt size is 60" x 68"

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Supplies Needed

(2) 2 ½" fabric rolls of Patrick's Promise by Marcus Fabrics,

2 Yards

R162112D
Vanilla



4 ½ yards R162110D Sky for backing and binding.

You will also need a fabric marker.

Ribbons and Rainbows

Please read all of the instructions before you begin.

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise stated.

Press the seams in the direction of the arrows.

Cutting

Separate each $2\frac{1}{2}$ " roll into (8) different color ways: red, orange, yellow, green, teal, blue, violet, and pink. Put aside the light blue and low volume backgrounds. You will notice that each strip contains (8) prints that are approximately $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ ". From each print, cut $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles in the quantities listed below:

Purple	52
Pink	50
Red	48
Orange	48
Yellow	48
Green	48
Teal	48
Blue	48

From the low volume vanilla fabric, cut:

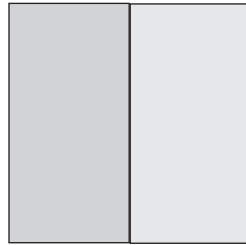
(13) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.
From these strips, cut (195) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, and

(8) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the short ends of these strips together and cut out:

(4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

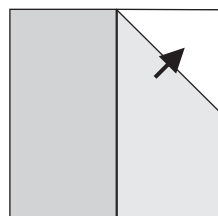
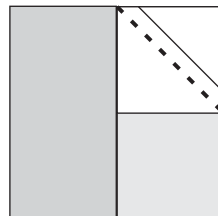
Sew the Ribbon Blocks:

Sew the long sides of (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles in the same color way together, as shown:



Blocks measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make (26) purple, (25) pink, (24) red, (24) orange, (24) yellow, (24) green, (24) teal, and (24) blue.

With a fabric marker, draw a line diagonally on the back of the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares. Carefully line up this square on top of a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " block and sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press the seam toward the background triangle, as shown:



Repeat this process with every block.

Use the image on the front of the pattern as a guide, and sew the blocks into rows. Press the seams open. Sew the rows together and press the seams in the direction of your choice.

The quilt center measures $52\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Sew the long side of a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " outer border rectangle to each long side of the quilt center and press the seams toward the outer border.

Sew a long side of the remaining $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " outer border rectangles to the top and bottom of the quilt, and press towards the outer border.

The quilt measures $60\frac{1}{2}$ " x $68\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Baste, quilt, bind and
