




Block 23: Baby Cone



Background Fabric:

A - (1) $3\frac{3}{4}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$

B - (2) $3\frac{3}{4}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$

C - (4) $3\frac{3}{4}'' \times 1''$

D - (2) $1'' \times 3\frac{3}{4}''$

E - (2) $1'' \times 1\frac{1}{4}''$

F - (2) $1'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$

G - (2) $1\frac{3}{4}'' \times 1''$

Ice Cream Fabric:

H - (1) $3\frac{3}{4}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$

I - (2) $3\frac{3}{4}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

J - (1) $1'' \times 3''$

Cone Fabric:

K - (1) $1'' \times 2''$

L - (1) $1'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$

M - (1) $1'' \times 1''$

1. Place fabrics in order according to diagram.

2. Join pieces to make horizontal rows, pressing seams open.

3. Join horizontal rows to complete block. Press these seams open.

Optional: you may wish to trim each seam allowance down to $\frac{1}{8}''$ after you have pieced it. It may help to reduce the bulk.
