



Block 33: Tiny Abode

A - (4) 1-1/4"

G - (1) 3/4" x 1"

B - (4) 1-1/4" x 2"

H - (1) 3/4" x 1-1/4"

C - (8) 1-1/4"

I - (1) 7/8" x 1-1/4"

D - (1) 3/4"

J - (1) 7/8" x 1-5/8"

E - (1) 3/4"

K - (1) 7/8" x 1-5/8"

F - (1) 3/4" x 1"

L - (1) 7/8" x 2"

1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of C squares.
2. Place C square RST with B rectangle on one side having raw edges even. Stitch on drawn line. Trim seam 1/4" away from drawn line according to diagram. Press seam open.
3. Repeat Step 2 on opposite side of B rectangle. Make a total of (4). These are Star Point Units.
4. Arrange center pieces according to diagram. Beginning with center D square, join pieces in order, pressing seams toward the new piece each time. (You may want to trim seams to 1/8" after stitching.) This center unit should measure 2" square.
5. Join a Star Point unit to opposite sides of center matching diagram. Press seams open.
6. Join a Star Point unit to opposite sides of center matching diagram. Press seams open. Make 2.
7. Join row from Step 6 to top and bottom of block according to diagram. Press seams open.
