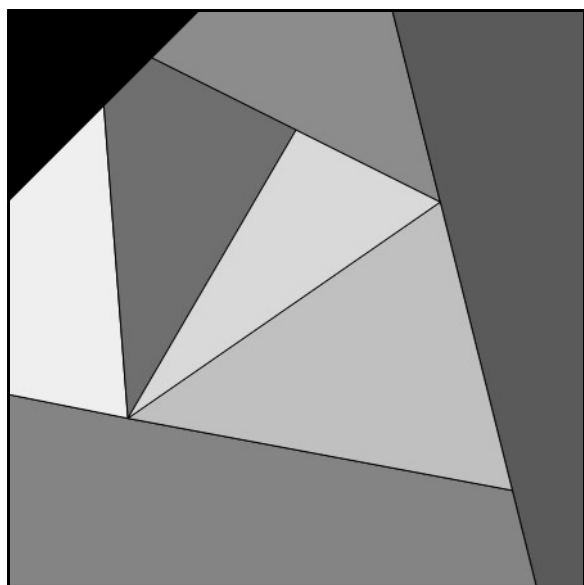
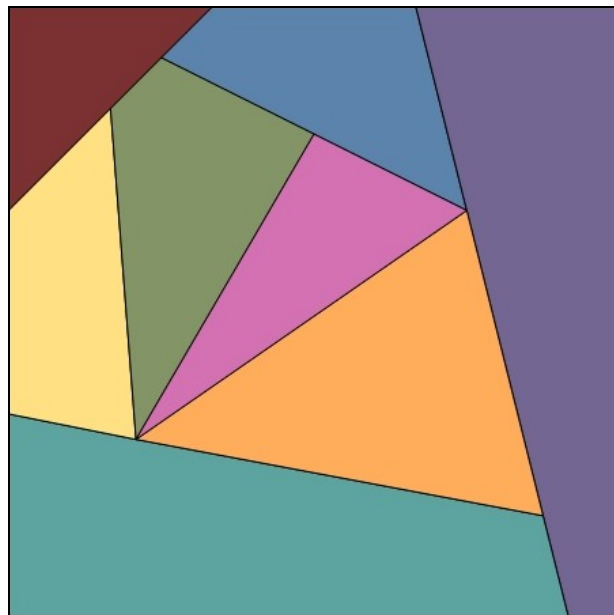


Block 57: Bit Crazy








(1) 4" square of muslin or scrap fabric.
This is your foundation and it will not show.

Assorted scraps of various color and size.

Note:

Your crazy block will be uniquely your own. Instead of trying to match the diagram exactly, let your scraps and various pieces determine the outcome.

1.  Place a small scrap of fabric right side up near the center of the foundation block. Pin in place.
2.  Place another scrap of fabric (roughly the same length) on one raw edge of first piece, RST. Stitch 1/4" from raw edge of top piece, sewing thru all thicknesses.
3.  Open top piece and press flat.
4.  Place another scrap RST along another raw edge. Stitch and press open.
5.  Place another scrap RST along another raw edge. Stitch and press open.
6. Continue adding fabric scraps RST in same manner along raw edges of center scrap. Press each piece open before adding another. Cover the foundation fabric completely. Trim block to 3-1/2".
