

Finishing

Background Fabric: cut (22) 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles **A**
(4) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles **B**
(7) 3-1/2" x WOF strips (Outer Border)

Gather up the following from what you have made:

(72) 3-1/2" Pieced blocks
(71) 3-1/2" Chain blocks
(26) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" Side Blocks
(168) Four Patch Sashing Squares
(310) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" Sashing Strips

Using the diagram on the following page and layout your pieces accordingly.

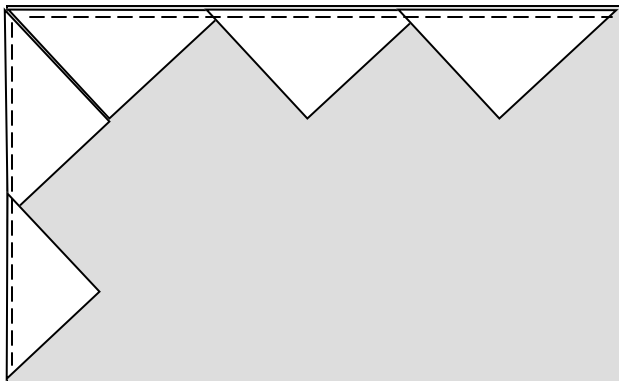
Join pieces and blocks into horizontal rows.
Press seams toward background fabric.

Join rows to finish top.
Press these seams as desired.

Add borders.

Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
Quilt as desired.

Place Prairie Points on right side of quilt top, having raw edges even with edge of quilt and points facing center of quilt. Pin Prairie Points around perimeter of quilt in this way, overlapping them 1/4" from raw edge and having folded sides meet up in the corners as shown. Baste Prairie Points in place close to raw edge. Prairie Points will point away from center when quilt edge is finished.
