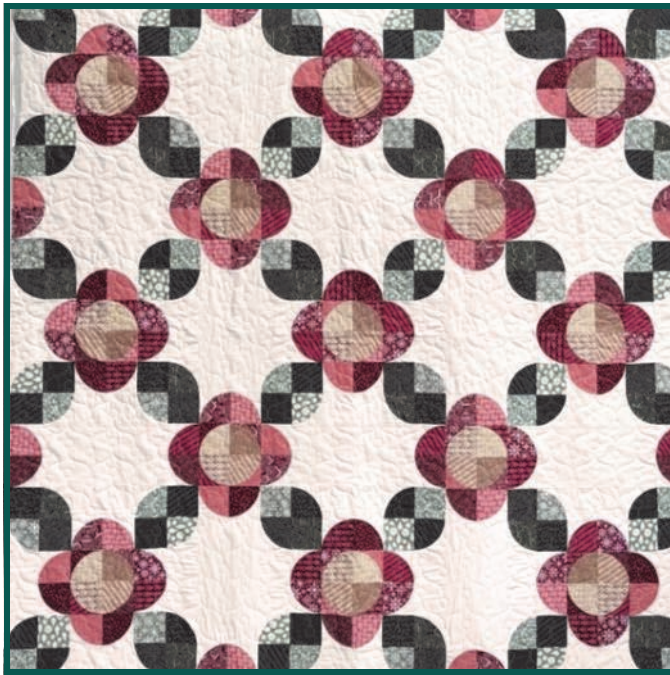

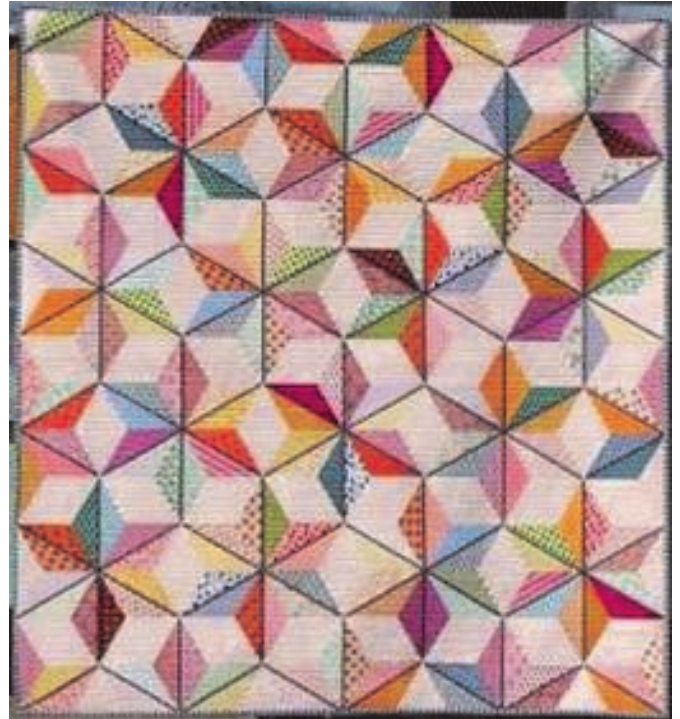

Biscoff Pumpkin Bread

2 c flour Bake at 350°

1/2 t salt Cream together the butter and sugar, then mix in the cookie butter.

1 t baking soda Add eggs, vanilla and pumpkin puree. Mix until smooth.

1/2 t baking powder In a separate bowl, whisk together the flour, salt, baking soda, baking powder

2 t pumpkin pie spice and pumpkin spice. Add the dry to the wet and fold gently to combine.

1/2 c unsalted butter (softened) Pour into a 9x5 loaf pan.

1/2 c biscoff cookie butter **For topping:**

1/2 c sugar Mix the cookies, brown sugar and flour,

1/2 c brown sugar then pour in the melted butter and mix.

2 eggs Sprinkle on top of prepared batter.

1 (15oz) can pure pumpkin

1 t vanilla Bake for 60-70 minutes or until a

Topping: toothpick comes out clean.

1/2 c crushed biscoff cookies

2 T brown sugar

2 T unsalted butter (melted)

2 T flour
