Raspberry Syrup:	Makes a dozen large cookies Bake at 325º for 15 minutes				

Raspberry Syrup:

1 c frozen raspberries

Cook in saucepan over med. heat, stirring constantly until they are broken

1/4 c sugar

down and syrupy, about 10 min. Pour through a mesh strainer. Set aside.

Cookies:

2 c flour

1. Roughly chop 1/2 c frozen raspberries into small pieces. Let freeze

1 1/2 T cornstarch

2. Whisk together flour, baking powder, cornstarch & salt. Set aside.

1 1/2 t baking powder 3. In large bowl, beat butter & sugar until soft and creamy. Slowly

1/2 t salt

beat in the cornstarch/water mixture, milk, and the raspberry syrup into the creamed butter and

1/2 c unsalted butter

sugar. Slowly add flour mixture until just combined. Mix in 3-4 drops of red food coloring if desired.

1-1/4 c sugar

4. Gently fold in frozen chopped raspberries. Do not over-mix. Cover & freeze for 1hour.

2 heaping T cornstarch mixed with 3 T water 5. Use an ice cream scoop to scoop dough onto parchment lined baking sheet.

3 T milk

6. Coat each ball in granulated sugar.

3 T raspberry syrup

7. Place dough balls 3-4" apart on baking sheet and bake.

3 drops red food coloring

8. Immediately reshape the cookies when they come out of the oven by using a spatula

1/2 c frozen raspberries

to push them into a circle. Let cool for 5 minutes before transferring to a cooling rack.
