Betty Kellenberger, Carson City's Own "Legend"

Come hear Betty's story as she shares her experiences on the Appalachian Trail and shows a collection of her favorite quilts as well.



**Betty's Appalachian Trail Story
Noon, Friday, February 6, 2026**

Betty Kellenberger's fascination with the Appalachian Trail began in elementary school, when she first read about the 14-state footpath in *Weekly Reader* magazine. Decades later, that childhood spark still burns.

In September, the 80-year-old Carson City resident became the oldest woman to complete a thru-hike on the 2,197-mile Appalachian Trail, which passes through Georgia, North Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, West Virginia, Maryland, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York, Connecticut, Massachusetts, Vermont, New Hampshire and Maine.

We are thrilled to have Betty Kellenberger at Seven Sisters, sharing and inspiring her fellow quilters. She is a one of a kind personality, and we are very blessed to know her.

Ham, Cheese & Chive Muffins

375^g

2 c flour	Place paper liners in a muffin pan and spray with cooking spray.
2-1/2 t baking powder	Combine flour, baking powder, baking soda, garlic, chives & salt
1/2 t baking soda	in a mixing bowl. Make a well in the center of the flour.
1/4 t salt	In a separate bowl, whisk together sugar, egg, butter and mustard
1 t garlic powder	until well blended, then whisk in buttermilk.
1 T sugar	
1 egg	Add the egg mixture to the well and
4 T butter melted	stir until just combined. Do not
1 T Dijon Mustard	over mix. Gently fold in cheese & meat.
1 c buttermilk	Spoon mixture evenly into the
1-1/2 c cheddar cheese (shredded)	prepared muffin pan. Bake 25 min or
1 c diced ham or bacon	until golden and a toothpick inserted in
1/4 c chopped chives	the center comes out clean.

****You can split these in half and serve with a fried egg and a 'schmear' of Dijon. Enjoy!**



Dear Sisters,

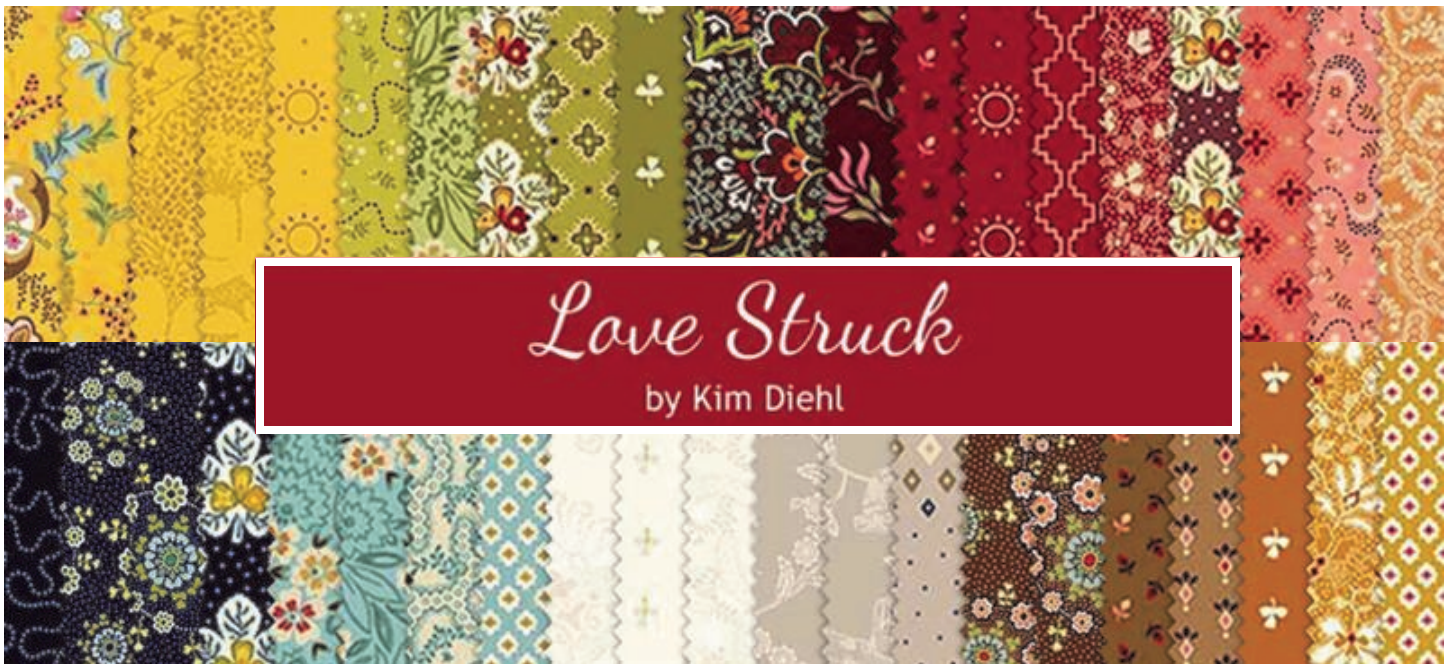
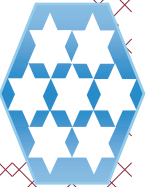
