



Vanilla Pear Mocktail

Serves 4

3 cups pear juice

2 vanilla bean pods (cut in half & partially sliced open leaving the beans inside)

1 T maple syrup

1 c sparkling water

1 lemon or lime wedge

2T cinnamon sugar

Ice

Fresh thyme or rosemary spring for garnish



Add the pear juice, maple syrup and vanilla bean pods to a pitcher. Give it a few stirs to release some of the beans. Refrigerate for 30 minutes or up to four hours. Right before serving, prep 4 glasses by rubbing a lemon or lime wedge over the side rim. Pour the cinnamon sugar onto a flat plate. Dip glasses in the cinnamon to coat. Pour 1 cup of sparkling water into the pitcher and give it a stir. Add a handful of ice to each glass. Fill each glass with the sparkling vanilla pear mocktail blend. Garnish each glass with a vanilla bean pod and Sprigs of thyme or rosemary (optional). Enjoy!
