

# Under the Harvest Moon

64" x 70"

## Fabric:

(2) Jelly Rolls (from the same collection)  
Batting –2 yd  
Backing– 2yd (wideback) or 3 7/8yd (45")  
Binding –3/4yd

Notes:

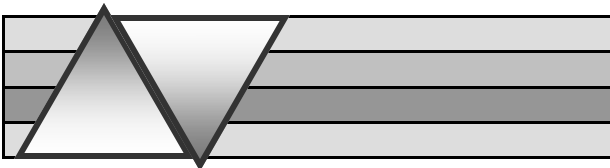
Press all seams open.

Also needed:

8 1/2" 60 degree Triangle Ruler

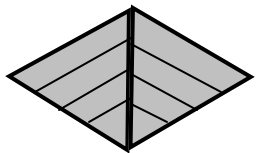


1. Choose (4) Jelly Roll Strips. Stitch them into pairs of twos, using 1/4" seam. Join pairs of twos to make a set of four. This strip set should measure exactly 8 1/2". Measure to make sure. Make one more strip set identical to this one.

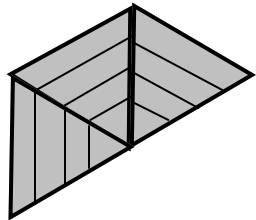


2. Place a 60 Degree Triangle on the strip set, having the 8 1/2" line on the lower edge of the fabric. Cut a total of (12) triangles from the two strip sets, turning the triangle up and down in order to make the best use of your strip set. Separate these triangles into sets of (6) that look exactly the same.

3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make a total of (20) strip sets, having (2) identical sets of each.



4. Join (2) identical triangles, matching seams. Press seam.



5. Add a third identical triangle, resulting in a half hexagon. Press seam.

6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5, to make a total of (40) half hexagons.

7. Arrange half hexagons to match photo. Stitch half hexagons into vertical rows. Press seams. Join vertical rows to finish quilt top.
