Color 1 (9900 80)-4 yds.
Color 2 (9900 200)- 31/4 yds. - Bkgd.
Backing - $43 / 4$ yds.

## Cutting:

## Color 1- Orange

-Cut 17 strips - $5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for large triangles.
-Cut 5 strips $-33 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. From the strips, cut 50 squares $33 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3{ }^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Cut squares once diagonally to make 100 corner triangles.
-Cut 8 strips $-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF. Set aside for binding.

## Color 2- White

-Cut 17 strips - $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for large triangles.
-Cut 5 strips - $33 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF. From the strips, cut 48 squares $33 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 33^{3 / 4}$. Cut squares once diagonally to make 96 corner triangles.

## Cutting Large Triangles

- Using the Marti Michell Large Kaleido Ruler (\#8642), cut 12 triangles from each $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Cut a total of 196 triangles from each color.


Optional edge-stitching - for pieced borders/edges, we recommend stay-stitching a continuous seam 1/8" from the edge of the quilt top. This keeps seams together during machine-quilting.

## Finishing:

1. Using a diagonal seam, join the 8 remaining strips end to end. Press seams open. Fold prepared strip in half wrong sides together and press to make the binding.
2. Layer, Quilt, and Bind.

## Cutting (cont.)

Color 1 From the $5-3^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips cut $50-33 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
orange Cut squares once diagonally to make 100 corner triangles.


From the $5-33 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips cut $48-3^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 33 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Color 2 white triangles.


## Construction:

Step 1 Assemble triangle units. White always on the bottom and orange always on the top.

With right sides together stitch a scant $1 / 4$ " on the right side of the orange triangle.

Step 3 Press seam to orange/dark side. Note: White triangle should always be on the left in the stitched pair.


Repeat Steps 1-3 to make 196 pairs of triangle units.


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## Construction (cont.)

Step 4 Sew 2 stitched triangle units from Step 3 together. Press seams toward the orange.


Step 5 Align center points, nest seams and stitch 2 four triangle units together. Press seam open.


## Assemble Blocks - Block 1

Add the orange corner triangles to the white triangles in block. Press seams toward orange.


Square blocks to measure $10^{1 / 2}$ " $\times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ with seams.

Make 25 blocks with orange corners.

## Assemble Blocks - Block 2

Add the white corner triangles to the orange triangles in block. Press seams toward orange.


Square blocks to measure $10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ with seams.

Make 24 blocks with white corners..

## Assemble Rows - Total of 7

Row 1-Requires 4 Block1s and 3 Block 2 s Using a $1 / 4$ " seam stitch 4 rows. Press seams open.


Row 2- Requires 4 Block 2 s and 3 Block 1s
Using a $1 / 4$ " seam stitch 3 rows. Press seams open.
