# Grandpa's Cabin

70" x 70"

## Fabric:

(3) full panels from Lake Views – Holly Taylor by MODA  
-or (41) 6" finished panel blocks

5/8 yd total of assorted blue prints –or (8) 2 1/2" strips  
5/8 yd total of assorted cream prints –or (8) 2 1/2" strips  
5/8 yd total of assorted green prints –or (8) 2 1/2" strips

1/2 yd Inner Border  
1 1/4 yd Outer Border


Backing: 4 1/4 yd of 45" fabric  
—or—  
2 1/8 yd of 108" fabric

2 1/8 yd Batting  
2/3 yd Binding

## Cutting:

1. Separate the panel blocks from each other. Then trim each panel block to 6 1/2" square.
2. From the each of the blue/green/cream prints, cut (8) 2 1/2" strips.  
You should have a total of (24) 2 1/2" strips.
3. From Inner Border fabric, cut (6) 2 1/2" strips
4. From Outer Border fabric, cut (7) 6 1/2" strips.

## Block Construction:



1. From assorted print strips, choose a blue, green and a cream strip. Stitch these strips together according to diagram above, using a 1/4" seam. Press seams in either direction.
2. Repeat Step 1 for all 2 1/2" strips to make (8) strip sets.
3. Cut each strip set into (6) 6 1/2" squares.

**Optional:** You may wish to trim the panel blocks to 6 1/4" square to eliminate the outer edge of the block. In that case, trim strip set squares into 6 1/4" blocks also.

## Notes:

~All seams are 1/4".  
~RST –right sides together.

This project was designed to be one of the easiest projects you could ever put together.

Experiment with colors choices to see how the frames draw attention to the block within.

**Layout:**

1. Place the panel blocks and the strip set blocks in order according to the diagram below, alternating between panel block, then strip set block. Refer to diagram for positioning strip set block in order to see the design around the panel blocks.



2. Stitch blocks together into horizontal rows. Press seams in each row in the opposite direction than the row before and the row after.
3. Join rows together nesting the vertical seams from one row to the next, in order for them to line up. Press these long horizontal seams in either direction.

**Borders:**

1. Join all Inner Border strips together end to end. Press seams open. Measure quilt top from top to bottom and add 2" to this measurement. Using this measurement, cut (2) border strips from long border strip for side borders.
2. Find and mark center of both border strips. Find and mark center of quilt top. Pin centers, then continue pinning border to sides of quilt. Stitch sides borders in place with 1/4" seam. Press seams toward border. Trim top and bottom even with quilt top.
3. Measure quilt top from side to side through Inner Borders and add 2" to this measurement. Using this measurement, cut (2) border strips from long border strip for top and bottom borders.
4. Join top and bottom Inner Borders to quilt top following Step 2.
5. Join all Outer Border strips together end to end and repeat steps 1—3 to add Outer Border to quilt.

Quilt, bind and give to your favorite fisherman!
