

# Juniper Cathedral Windows Rag Quilt

## Fabric:

(72) 10" Brushed Cotton Print Squares

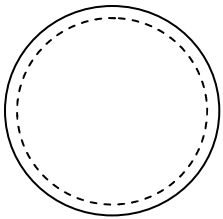
5 yd Brushed Cotton Neutral for Backing (cut into 72 10" squares)

## Cutting:

Using circle template, cut all 10" squares into circles.

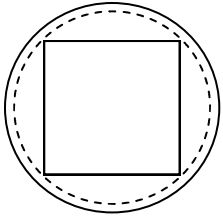
(We used **Creative Grids Circle Savy Ruler**)

## Block Construction:



1. Layer (1) Print circle and (1) Neutral backing circle wrong sides together.  
Pin outer edges together.

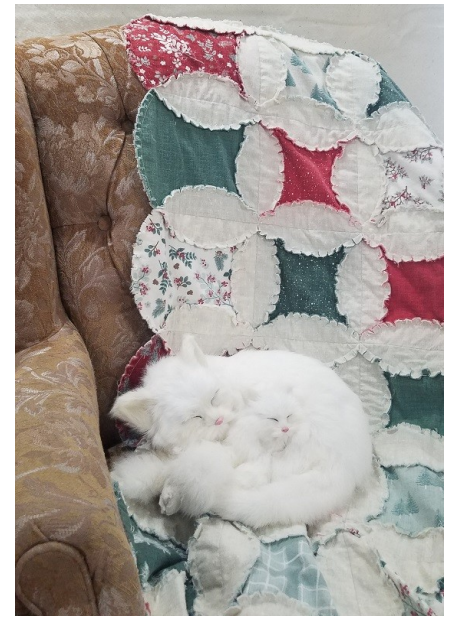
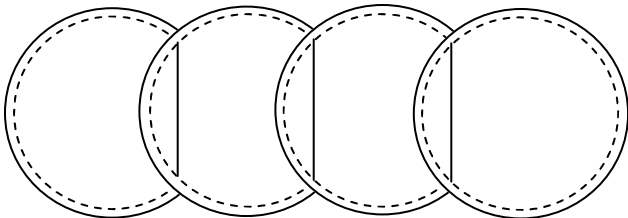
2. Stitch around outside of circle 3/8" from edge. Repeat for all (72) Print and Neutral circles.



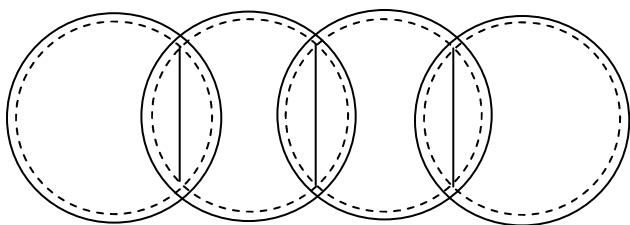
3. Trace a 6 1/2" square in the center of the print circles. The corners of the square should touch the stitching line that runs around the circle.

4. Layout circles as desired, 8 circles across and 9 circles down.

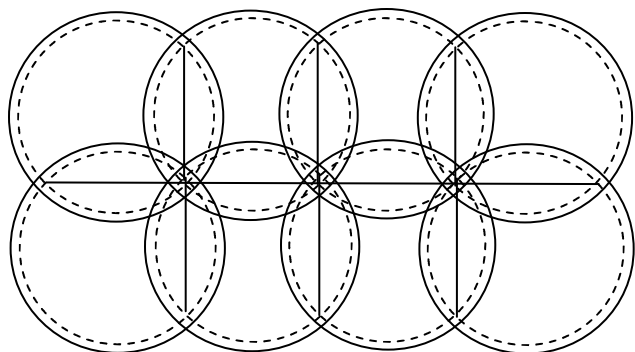
5. Sew the circles together into rows, wrong sides together, stitching along marked line. (You may wish to sew a bit beyond the 3/8" stitching line to ensure you will not leave gaps in your stitching when you sew these rows together.)



6. Press seams open, flattening the flaps down on top of the circles. Stitch the flaps down following the stitching line you created on Step 2.



7. Layer rows wrong sides together and stitch along line, stitching through all thicknesses.

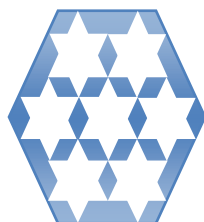


8. Press these flaps open and stitch down following a figure eight pattern along the row. Do the same to the opposite side.

9. Clip all seam allowances about every 1/2" being careful not to clip through the seam.

10. Wash and dry to fluff seam allowances.

11. Cuddle and enjoy!



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
