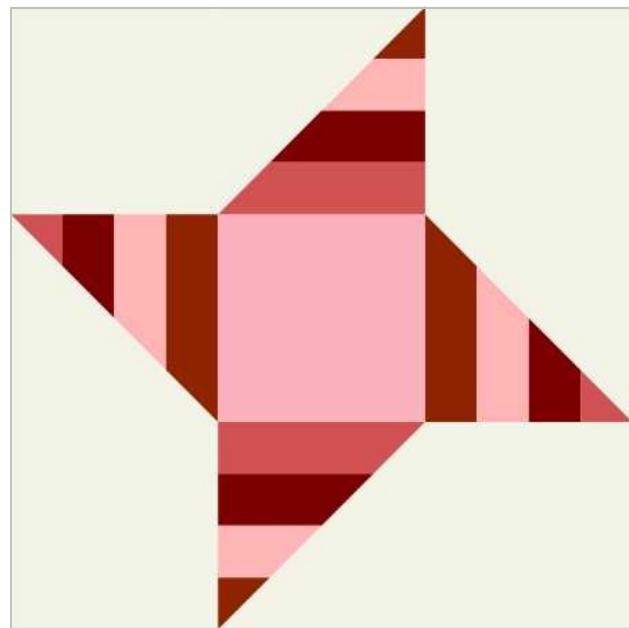


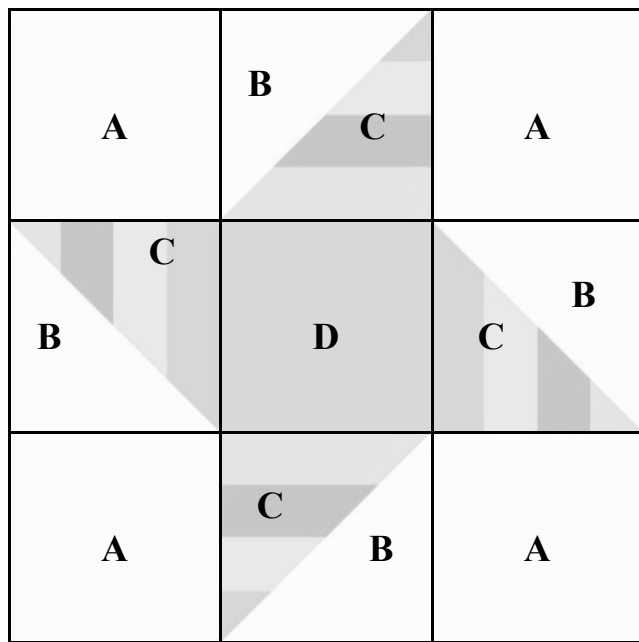
# Sisterhood Sampler Block 1


## Ms. Ellen



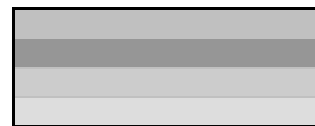

B- (2) 3" 

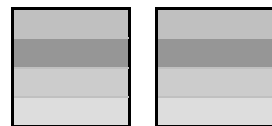
C- (4) assorted 1 1/4" x 7"

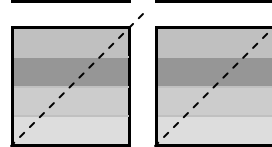

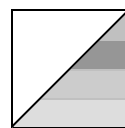
