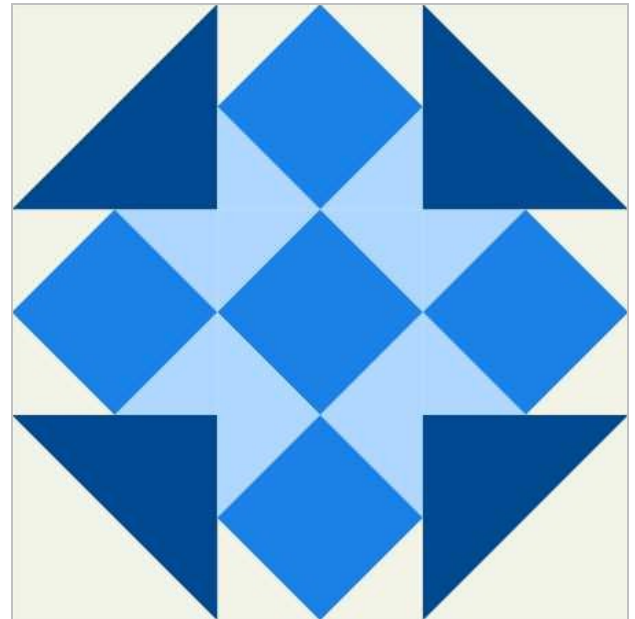


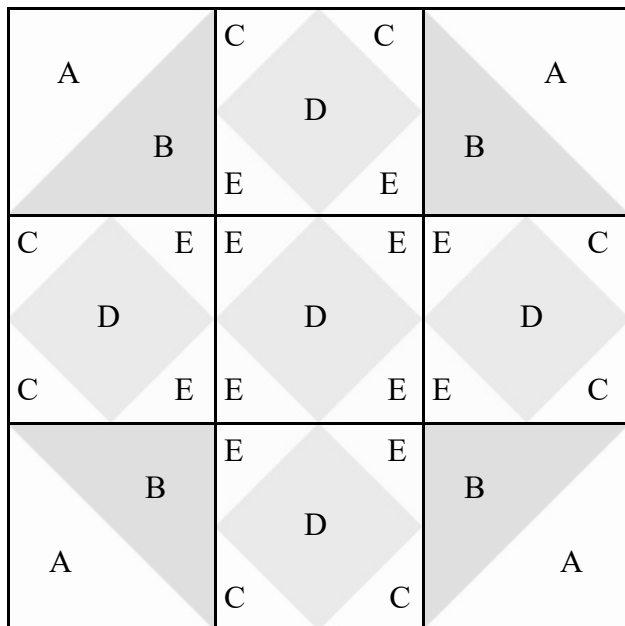


## Grandma Lucille




A - (2) 2 7/8"
