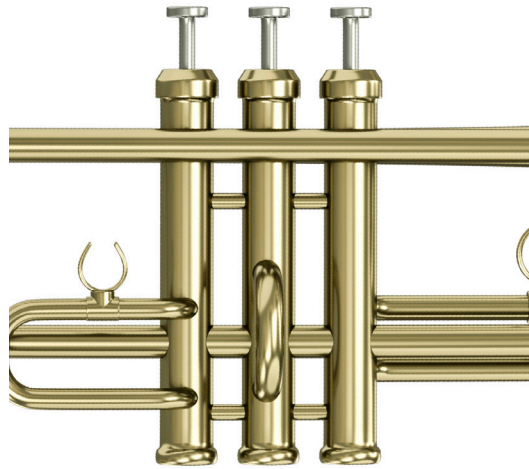
MASTER CLASSES
