

Quilt is 60½" x 76½"



FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Prints: 1 Jelly Roll* or 36 strips $-2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42"

Background: 4 yards

Binding: 5% yard

Backing: 5 yards

*Jelly Roll = $40 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric (WOF) strips

Cutting Requirements:

WOF = width of fabric.

From your Jelly Roll:

- From **each** of (36) strips, cut:
 - (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (144 total). Set aside (2) for another project.

From background fabric, cut:


- (3) 4 ½" × WOF strips. From strips, subcut:
 - (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " × $8\frac{1}{2}$ " B rectangles.
 - (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " × $6\frac{1}{2}$ " D rectangles.
 - (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " × $4\frac{1}{2}$ " C squares.
 - (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × $4\frac{1}{2}$ " A rectangles.

From background fabric, cont:

- (142) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.
- (142) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares.
- (19) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Set aside for sashing.

From binding fabric, cut:

• (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips.



Piecing, Assembly, and Finishing:

Unless specified otherwise, all seams are a scant 1/4". Arrows indicate pressing direction.

MAKE BLOCKS

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the (142) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares and (142) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, as shown.

For (142) Jelly Roll rectangles, place a background square right sides together onto the top end and a background rectangle on the bottom end. Sew together on the drawn lines, trim a 1/4" seam allowance, and press as shown.

Stitch together (2) units to make a block measuring 4 ½" × 10 ½". Make 71.

Join the (19) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF background strips together end to end and cut (10) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " vertical sashing strips.


ASSEMBLE AND FINISH

Arrange blocks and A-D (rectangles and squares) and sew together into (11) columns. Join the columns to (10) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " vertical sashing strips to make the quilt center.


Join the (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips together end to end. Cut (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " × $72\frac{1}{2}$ " lengths and sew to sides of quilt center.

Join the (4) 2 ½" × WOF strips together end to end. Cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " lengths for top and bottom borders and join to quilt center.

Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!





4 yards of coordinating background (RSS Starry White on Natural RS4109 65)





5% yard of binding fabric (Linear RS1051 13)
