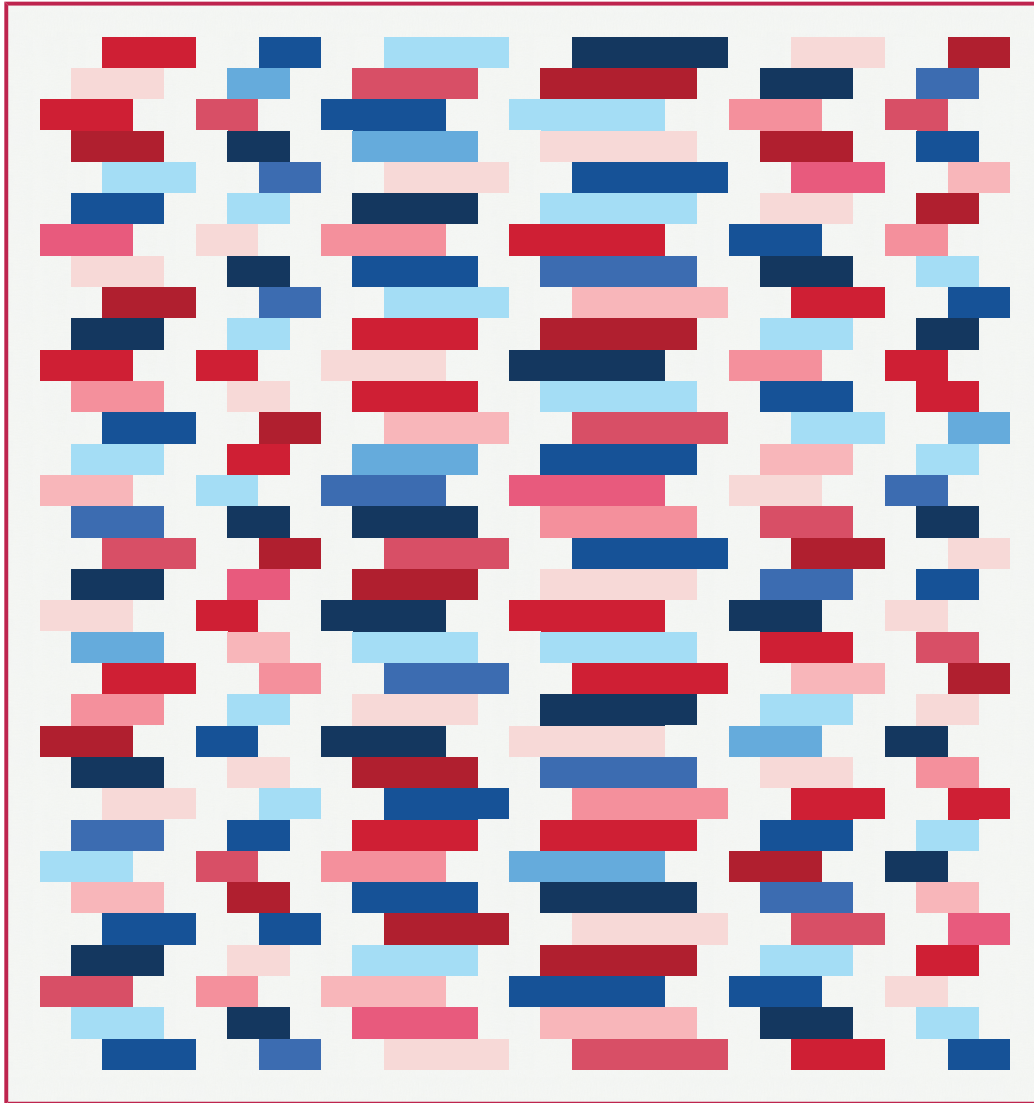




CROOKED ROADS

Pattern by Susan Guzman for *moda*

Quilt Size: 66½" × 70½"



FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Prints: 1 Jelly Roll* or 33 strips – 2½" × 42"

Background: 2½ yards

Binding: ⅝ yard

Backing: 4½ yards

*Jelly Roll = 40 – 2½" × width of fabric (WOF) strips

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Quilt Size: 66½" x 70½"

Cutting Requirements:

WOF = width of fabric.

From Jelly Roll:

- From each of (33) strips, cut:
 - (1) 2½" x 10½" rectangle.
 - (1) 2½" x 8½" squares.
 - (2) 2½" x 6½" rectangle.
 - (2) 2½" x 4½" squares.

From background fabric, cut:

- (33) 2½" x WOF strips. Set aside 8 strips for border. From 25 strips, subcut:
 - (182) 2½" x 4½" rectangles.
 - (32) 2½" x 2½" squares.

From binding fabric, cut:

- (8) 2½" x WOF strips.

Piecing, Assembly, and Finishing:

Arrows indicate pressing direction.

MAKE THE ROWS

- Gather (6) 2½" x 4½" background rectangles and the following Jelly Roll rectangles: (2) 2½" x 6½", (2) 2½" x 4½", (1) 2½" x 8½", and (1) 2½" x 10½". Lay out and sew into a row as shown to make an A row. Make 9.
- Gather (2) 2½" background squares (5) 2½" x 4½" background rectangles, and the same Jelly Roll rectangles as step 1. Lay out and sew into a row as shown to make a B row. Make 16.
- Using the same background and Jelly Roll rectangles as step 1 and paying attention to the layout, sew into a row as shown to make a C row. Make 8.

ASSEMBLE AND FINISH

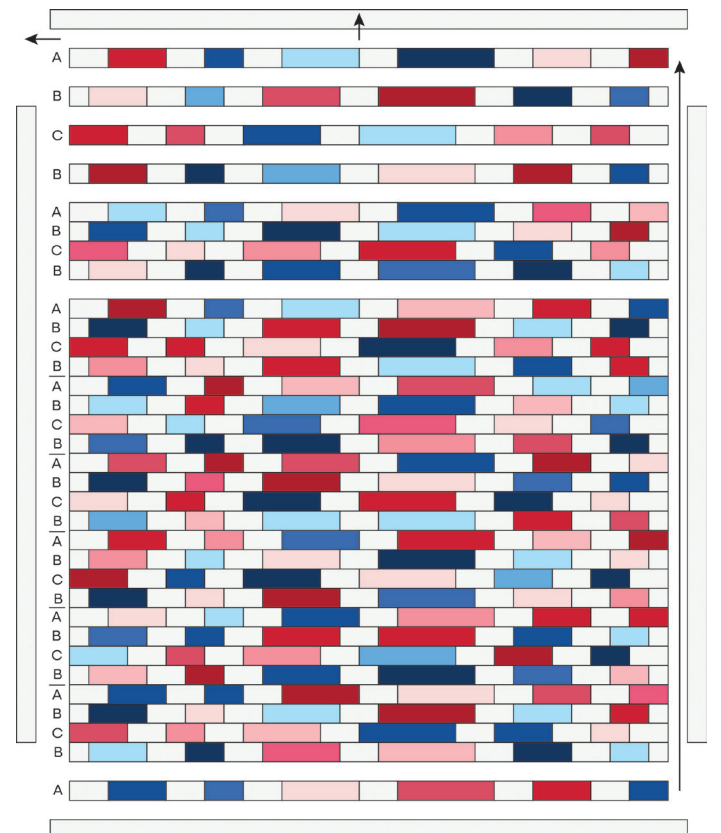
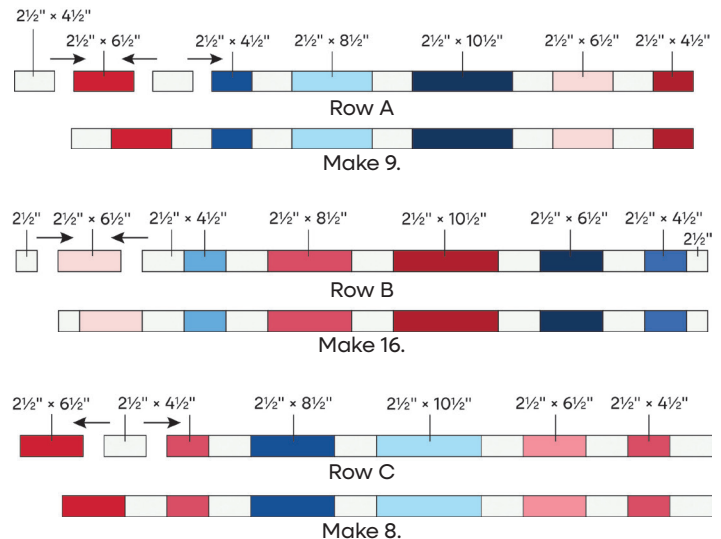
Arrange the rows as shown and join together to make the quilt center.

Using diagonal seams, sew the (8) 2½" x WOF background strips together end-to-end to make one long strip. From strip, cut (2) 2½" x 66½" strips and sew to each side of the quilt center.

ASSEMBLE AND FINISH, CONT.

Cut (2) 2½" x 70½" strips and sew to the top and bottom edges to finish the quilt top.

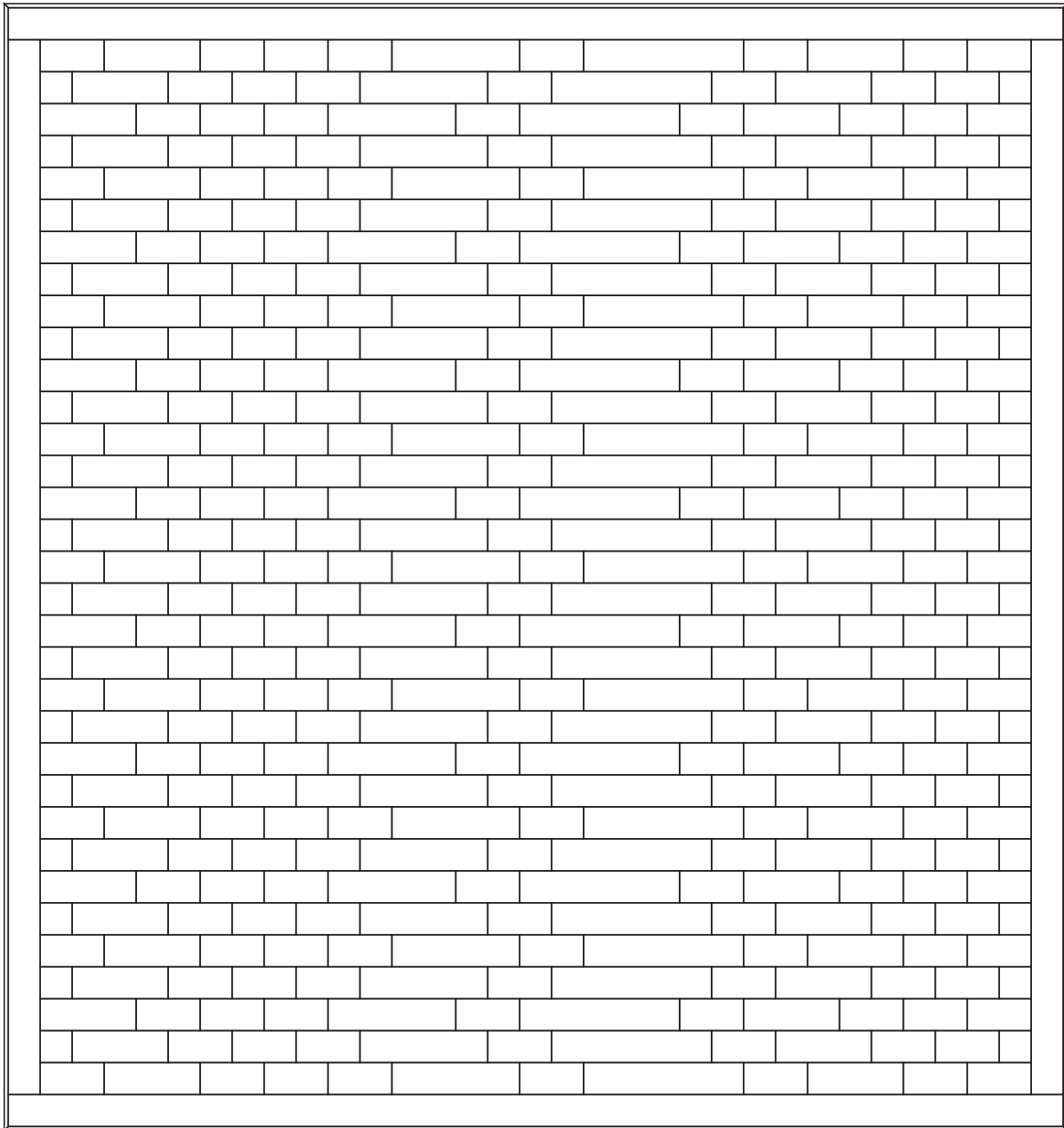
Layer, baste, quilt and bind. Enjoy!

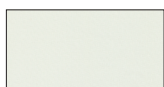

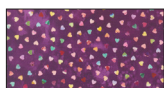
