Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine with
power cords and manual (just in case)
Thread
Machine needles
Snips or trimming scissors
Seam ripper

Basic Quilting Supplies

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
Marking Pencil (Mechanical will do)
Small cutting mat
Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so
Invisigrip (Optional)
Best Press or light starch (Optional)

Pre-Cutting Instructions

- Fabrics are denoted with an A or B to indicate that this should be different fabric colors.
- Strips are cut on the width of the fabric or wof based on 40" of usable fabric
- Cutting will provide you with plenty of practice material for the purpose of class participation.

Economy Block 4" finished Unit	Fabric A Cut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" Cut (4) 2 ¾" squares; sub cut on the diagonal Cut (4) 3 ¼" squares; sub cut on the diagonal Fabric B Cut (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" Cut (4) 2 ¾" squares; sub cut on the diagonal Cut (4) 3 ¼" squares; sub cut on the diagonal
Snail's Trail Block 4" finished unit*	Fabric A Cut (1) strip 1 ¾" x 12" Cut (1) 2 ¾" square; sub cut on the diagonal Cut (1) 3 ¼" square; sub cut on the diagonal Fabric B Cut (1) strip 1 ¾" x 12" Cut (1) 2 ¾" square; sub cut on the diagonal Cut (1) 3 ¼" square; sub cut on the diagonal
