5-101 Basic Wedge Star Block Learn to use the same tool with a variety of Wedge Star blocks. Expand your skill, step-by-steps under the guidance of our instructor. This eight-pointed star has several variations and you will want to make each one. At the sixth class, you will be ready to create your own simple layout using a simple Nine-block approach.

*Required tools: Wedge Star™ Tool. Tucker Trimmer™ III

*Required Design Sheet: Basic Wedge Star

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine with power cords
Thread
Machine needles
Snips or trimming scissors
Seam ripper
Pins

Basic Quilting Supplies

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
Marking Pencil (mechanical will do)
Small cutting mat
Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so
Invisigrip (Optional)
Best Press or light starch (Optional)
Pressing Stick (optional)

Pre-Cutting Instructions

- Strips are cut on the width of the fabric or wof based on 40" of usable fabric
- Cutting will provide you with plenty of practice material for the purpose of class participation.

Block	Cutting
Basic Wedge Star Block	Diamonds Cut (1) strip 1 3/4" x wof Small Wedges Cut (1) strip 2 3/4" x wof Corner Squares Cut (2) 3" squares; sub cut once on diagonal
Mixed Wedge Star Block*	Diamonds Cut (1) strip 1 3/4" x wof Small Wedges Cut (1) strip 2 3/4" x wof Large Wedges Cut (1) strip 4" x wof Corner Squares Cut (2) 3" squares; sub cut once on diagonal
Wedge Star Block*	Large Wedges Color #1 Cut (1) strip 4" x wof Large Wedges Color #2 Cut (1) strip 4" x wof Corner Squares Cut (2) 3" squares; sub cut once on diagonal
