5-401 Edged Wedge Star Block

It's an illusion. It looks like stars on top of stars, but without all the layers. You have the skills from the previous classes, why not push yourself a little further and learn how to make the beautiful Edged Wedge Star Block.

*Required tools: Wedge Star™ Tool, Tucker Trimmer™ I or III

*Required Technique Sheet: Edged Wedge from Studio 180 Design

*Required Design Sheet: Edged Wedge from Tucker University

*These items can be purchased at your local quilt shop or at the class

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine with power cords

Thread

Machine needles

Snips or trimming scissors

Seam ripper

Pins

Basic Quilting Supplies

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade

Marking Pencil (mechanical will do)

Small cutting mat

Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so

Invisigrip (Optional)

Best Press or light starch (Optional)

Pressing Stick (Optional)

Rotating Cutting Mat (Optional)

Pre-Cutting Instructions

- Strips are cut on the width of the fabric or wof based on 40" of usable fabric
- Cutting will provide you with plenty of practice material for the purpose of class participation.

Block	Cutting
Edged Wedge Star Block	Diamond Strip Cut (1) 1 ½" strip x wof (label) Edging Strips Cut (2) 1 ⅛" strip x wof (label) Small Wedges/Background Cut (1) 2 ¾" x wof Corner Squares Cut (2) 3" squares; sub cut once on the diagonal

Note: Feel free to cut an additional set for a second block since you can adjust the amount of edging that will appear in these block.
