

Preparations for Winter Blessings class:

- Recommend starching your fabric before class. There are many bias seams in this quilt and the starch helps stabilize the fabric.

Fabric Requirements:

Quilt made using Peppermint and Pine by Lamb Farm Designs for Marcus Fabrics™.

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| • Background | R791916D Multi Dots | 3 ¼ yds |
| • Hearts | R791915D Poppy Snowflakes | ½ yd |
| • Green star points and single leaf | R791914D Pine Holly | ⅝ yd |
| • Red star points | R791916D Red Dots | ⅜ yd |
| • Double leaves and binding | R791913D Hunter Swirly Twirly | ¾ yd |
| • Star centers | R791909D Multi Winter Folk | ⅓ yd* |
| *may need extra fabric if fussy cutting | | |
| • Backing 44/45" | | 3 ½ yds |
| • Backing – wide | | 1 ¾ yds |
| • Batting | | 62" x 70" |

Supplies needed for class:

- Sewing machine in good working order, power cord and ¼" foot
- Neutral thread
- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutter
- Pencil or pen for marking on your fabric
- Alphabitties or sticky notes, a way to label cut pieces
- Scissors
- Seam ripper
- Bias square ruler
- Cutting ruler(s)
- 4" x 2" flying geese ruler (finished size of flying geese)
- Power strip
- Additional favorite cutting rulers
- Pencil
- Notepaper
- Winter Blessings pattern will be supplied at the beginning of class
- Any of your favorite notions that you regularly use

Optional supplies:

- Small iron and ironing station for your personal use (if you want)
- Acorn Precision Piecing Easy Press pen and Seam Align glue
