

Eyelet Lace up Sweatshirt

With Heart Applique

Inspiration:

This very expensive skirt I saw in a boutique and it sparked the idea.

That's why we have beautiful machines, software and all the things so we can create what we want.



Supplies:

Sweatshirt
1/4 yard of fabric
Bias binding foot or just make thin fabric tubes
Iron on Stabilizer
Marking tool
Double sided tape for hem
Thread for Eyelets
8 by 12 hoop to do all three rows
or 6 by 10 to do three separate rows

Cut fabric to 1" strips or the size your Binder requires. The ties should finish around 1/4" .

1" by 45"

Make 6 Ties.

Optional to remove bottom ribbing and then hem to bottom, I cut away the ribbing.



Fuse Stabilizer to the back of the shirt. Mark the front and off set marks for the eyelet design.

Embroider the Design

Make small snips inside the eyelets, you don't have to cut out each square, just enough for the ties to go through. The fleece is kinda self healing.

The heart is a simple Applique, place it where you like.

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
