

Flower Farm Sampler

We will meet on the 3rd Saturday of the month during 2026 to work on one or two blocks each month. After 11 months, you will have all the blocks needed to make the sampler quilt. The class fee covers the 11 months of instruction.

You can either make the quilt using the fabric guidelines in the book, or you can do each block with different fabrics from your stash. The Flower Farm Sampler book by Shelley Cavanna is a requirement. I will share with you easier ways to cut out the blocks and some easier construction methods. After the first class, there will be cutting homework for next month's class so that we can focus on sewing the blocks. If you need any help choosing fabrics, I will be available at Amy's on Tuesdays and Fridays before the start date and can help you with your fabric selections.

Book-Flower Farm Sampler by Shelley Cavanna

Fabric-Fabric requirements can be found on page 17. You can use these guidelines for the quilt or use a variety of different fabrics for each block.

Rotary cutter and rulers-Stripology squared ruler and Bonnie Hunter Essential triangle ruler are helpful but not necessary.
