# Anita Goodesign Event Guest Procedures

Dear AGD Attendees:

We are taking precautions to give you a fun and healthy environment for our two day Embroidery Event.

**When you arrive through the front door:**

We will take your temperature and register your information, if your temperature is over 100 you will not be able to participate.

Please wear a mask or face shield at all times. If you have a medical issue, let us know.

You will be asked to wash or sanitize your hands before entering the event room.

Lunch will be provided in a box, so there will be no sharing of food or drinks.

We are team sewing, that means four people to an 8 foot table. If this makes you uncomfortable, there will be extra chairs and tables around the area to help spread everyone out. It may difficult to make a true 6 foot distance.

The machines are new and we will clean them before everyone takes a turn. PLEASE do not use anything on the machines to sanitize them without us knowing, it could damage the screens.

The AGD educator will also wear a mask as well as any staff members or helpers.

There will be fans to circulate the air, the room may not be as cold as we like, but exchanging the air is important.

These are choices we are making to help keep everyone safe, you may or may not agree with these choices, but it is how we are going to move forward.

If any of these protocols make you uncomfortable, I am sorry. You are welcome to take home the binder of designs and work independently from home. The class will not be video taped or virtually live.
