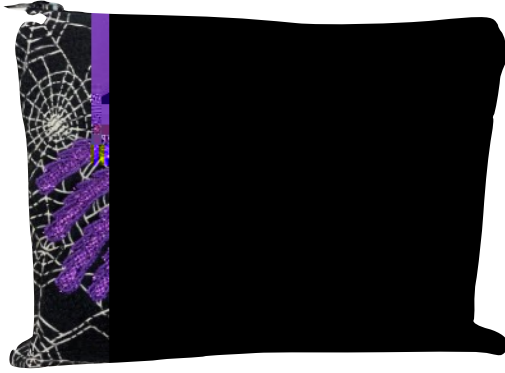


Mylar Spider Ditty Bag

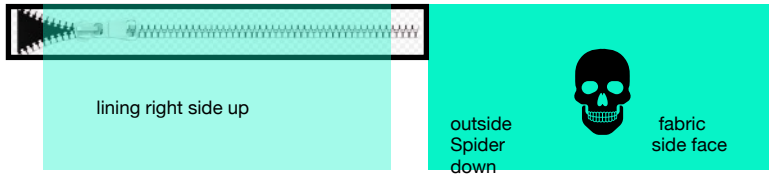


Supplies:
Mylar Sheet 5 by 7
Fabric for Bag, Two 6 by 9 pieces
Lining Fabric, Two 6 by 8 pieces
Fused with Soft n Stable or OESD Cotton or Batting
Threads, Black, White and Purple
12" Zipper
Sewing Thread to match your fabric

Hoop your fused Fabric in a 5 by 7 hoop,
Lay the Mylar sheet over the fabric.
Stitch color one, spider
Remove the excess Mylar from the Eye sockets.

Color 2 is White
Color 3 is Eye Pupal color
Color 4 is the Final Outline

Remove all the excess Mylar from the Spider

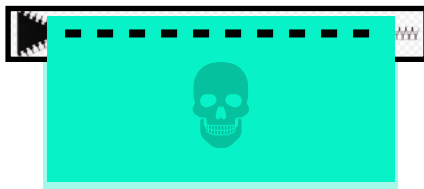


Lay the lining fabric, right side up

Place the zipper pull side up, along the top edge of your lining fabric.

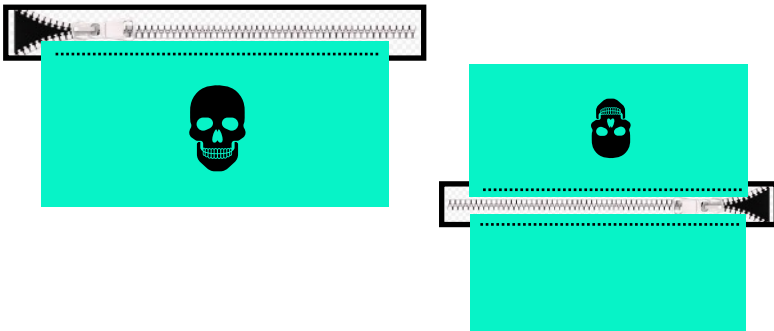
Making a sandwich, lay the Spider fabric right side down over the zipper.

The zipper should be longer on either side of the fabric.



Fold the pieces to the

Repeat with the other side of the bag, making the same zipper sandwich



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Mylar Spider Ditty Bag

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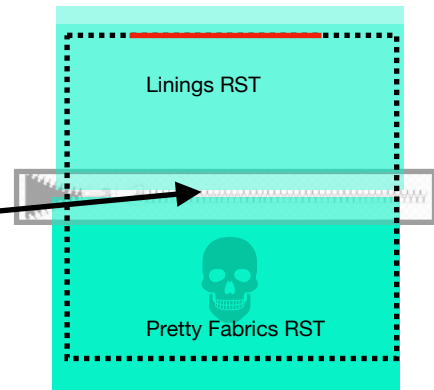
Open all the layer and match the two lining pieces and match the two outside pieces. You Zipper will fold in half to the right side of the zipper teeth.

MAKE SURE THE ZIPPER PULL IS IN THE CENTER

Stitch around all four sides, leaving open a turning opening at the lining bottom.

Trim the corners, turn and press.
DON'T PRESS THE MYLAR!

Stitch the lining closed



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
