



“On the Go” Bag

The project for our August 27th Vintage 221 Friends club will be what I call an “On the Go” bag. The finished bag is about 15” wide x 13” tall. It is flexible and can be easily folded up to fit inside a purse or pocket, making it an excellent extra shopping or craft tote. Made from the correct fabrics it would make a great reusable gift bag.

Required Materials:

¼ yd print fabric for the bag exterior
½ yd solid or coordinating fabric for the bag exterior and bag lining
40” of one inch webbing for handles
Small hook for key fob (optional- I will supply these)
¾ yd fusible interfacing- such as Pellon SF101 (optional)

Supplies

Rotary cutter and mat
Pins or clips
Fabric marker (Chalk, Frixion pen....)
Scissors
Thread and bobbin
