Class Date and time -

Pattern: The Anything Bag by Marguerite

Fabric requirements are listed on the pattern. Be aware that you will need both fusible foam lightweight fusible interfacing for this project. Pre-Class Work: please cut (and label) the pieces as indicated in the pattern. If you are not comfortable doing the cutting on your own, please wait until the class.

Sewing Tools:

- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutter
- Straight pins
- Seam ripper
- Pencil or fabric markers
- Thread
- Sewing machine with accessories and owner's manual
- Extra sewing machine needles in case of breakage
- Post it notes to label pieces

Rulers

- 6 ½" x 24" or 8 ½" x 24 ½" ruler
- 8 ½" or larger square ruler
- 3 ½" or 5" square ruler

TOQS Class Rules and Requirements

- Reservations are required for all classes!
- Payment for the initial class is required at the time of reservation!
- Cancellation: If you have to cancel your participation in a class and are able to provide 24 hour notice you will receive a voucher for your class fee, good for use against a future class. If you cancel the day of class you will receive a voucher for 1/2 of the class fee, good for use against a future class. If you are a no show or cancel after the course has started, then no refund is available. There is no refund for classes taught by visiting teachers or for quilt retreats.
- Please note the classrooms of TOQS are "Fragrance Free" zones.
