

Quilted Santa Hat

For the next meeting of the Featherweight Club the project will be a quilted Santa Hat. There are a few options on how to make this and supplies will depend on the method you choose.

The first method is to create a patchwork grid for the outer hat. For this style you will need the following materials:

- Ninety to one hundred 2 ½" squares of assorted Christmas fabric for the outer cap
- 1 yard of SF101
- ½ yard of fabric for the cap lining
- 8 ½" x 31" white fleece or furry fabric for the hat band and pom pom **(Note: I will supply this fabric).**



For the second method you will be quilting a solid piece of fabric for the outer cap. For this method you will need:

- ½ yard of fabric for the outer cap
- ½ yard of fabric for the cap lining
- One 18"x24" piece of fusible fleece
- ½" x 31" white fleece or furry fabric for the hat band and pom pom **(Note: I will supply this fabric).**



You will also need the following general sewing supplies regardless of the style you select

- Pins or clips
- Marking pens
- Cutting supplies (ruler, rotary cutter, mat, scissors)
- Thread and bobbins (hint: make sure you bring thread to match both the outer bag fabric and inner bag fabric)
- Thread and needles for hand sewing
