

## Quilted Santa Hat

For the next meeting of the Featherweight Club the project will be a quilted Santa Hat. There are a few options on how to make this and supplies will depend on the method you choose.

The first method is to create a patchwork grid for the outer hat. For this style you will need the following materials:

- Ninety to one hundred  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of assorted Christmas fabric for the outer cap
- 1 yard of SF101
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of fabric for the cap lining
- $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 31"$  white fleece or furry fabric for the hat band and pom pom **(Note: I will supply this fabric).**



For the second method you will be quilting a solid piece of fabric for the outer cap. For this method you will need:

- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of fabric for the outer cap
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of fabric for the cap lining
- One  $18" \times 24"$  piece of fusible fleece
- $\frac{1}{2}" \times 31"$  white fleece or furry fabric for the hat band and pom pom **(Note: I will supply this fabric).**



You will also need the following general sewing supplies regardless of the style you select

- Pins or clips
- Marking pens
- Cutting supplies (ruler, rotary cutter, mat, scissors)
- Thread and bobbins (hint: make sure you bring thread to match both the outer bag fabric and inner bag fabric)
- Thread and needles for hand sewing
