

# T-SHIRT QUILT BASICS

Let Donna show you the basic steps to making a lap-size t-shirt quilt. T-shirt quilts are great gifts for college students or as a memory of a loved one.

Part 1 of this class will take you through stabilizing and cutting your shirts.

Part 2 will start you on piecing the shirts into blocks and adding borders.

## SUPPLY LIST

### PART I

- 12—15 t-shirts, washed without fabric softener or dryer sheets (only 12 shirts will be used in this project but more can assist with layout)
- 5 yds (20" wide) fusible interfacing—Pellon 911F or similar
- 18" x 24" cutting mat (minimum size)
- Rotary cutter (with new blade)
- 12 1/2" square ruler or Stripology Ruler (CGRGE1)
- Scissors or shears
- NO SEWING MACHINE FOR THIS SESSION

### PART II

- Sewing Machine
- Machine Needles (jersey knit needles optional)
- Pre-wound bobbins (2 or 3 with lt gray thread)
- Light gray thread for piecing
- 2/3 yd black cotton
- 1 yd sashing fabric (to be purchased AFTER 1st class)
- Rotary cutter & mat
- Stripology ruler or 24" ruler
