Public Hearing-Sewer Connection Fee Increase

Roll call showed the following council members present:

Topic: Sewer Connection Fee Increase

Mayor Spencer called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Cp, Rick Hatch asked how the sewer connections work. Mayor Spencer explained that the property owner is responsible to run the sewer line from their house to the alley. The home owner is responsible for covering the cost of a backflow preventer. The city maintains the lines from the alley to the sewer system. Cp, Rick asked what size the lines are. The city's engineer stated that residential lines are four inch and businesses are typically larger.


Walt (Nate) Eiman asked where the sewer connections are located. Mayor Spencer explained that the only homes not on the sewer system are located on Squaw Creek, Rigby Rd. and the north side of the city across the tracks. There are a couple homes on the south of town as well. The residents that have access to the city's extended water line pay a higher rate.

Cp, Rick Hatch 2nd the motion. Motion passed 3-0.


