



Wing Clipper Supply List and Pre-cutting Instructions

1-301 Wing Clipper I[®], Pickets, and Quickets Learn the simple secrets to creating crisp, clean flying geese effectively and quickly. This method can be applied to any pattern that requires flying geese units. Since you usually have to make hundreds of these units at a time, why not make them perfect every time?

Expand the use of your Wing Clipper I[®] by learning how to make Pickets and Quickets. Once you begin to recognize these units, you will be surprised how often they appear in patterns from your favorite magazines and designers. You will want to add Pickets and Quickets to your border options.

Required Tools: Wing Clipper I[®], and Quilter's Magic Wand[®]

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine with
power cords and manual (just in case)
Thread
Machine needles
Snips or trimming scissors
Seam ripper

Basic Quilting Supplies

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
Marking Pencil (Mechanical will do)
Small cutting mat
Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so
Invisgrip (Optional)
Best Press or light starch (Optional)

Pre-Cutting Instructions

- Fabrics are denoted with an A or B to indicate that this should be different fabric colors.
- Strips are cut on the width of the fabric or wof based on 40" of usable fabric
- Cutting will provide you with plenty of practice material for the purpose of class participation.

Unit	Cutting
Flying Geese 2" x 4" finished Units	Fabric A: Cut (1) strip 5 ½" x wof; sub cut into (4) 5 ½" squares Fabric B: Cut (1) strip 3" x wof; sub cut into (16) 3" squares
Pickets 2" x 4" Finished Units	Fabric A: Cut (1) strip 2 ¾" x wof; sub cut into (4) 2 ¾" x 4 ½" rectangles Fabric B: Cut (1) strip 2 ¾" x wof; sub cut into (4) 2 ¾" squares
Quickets* 2" x 4" Finished Units	Fabric A: Cut (1) strip 5 ½" x wof; sub cut into (2) 5 ½" squares Fabric B: Cut (1) strip 3" x wof; sub cut into (4) 3" squares

*May have extra fabric from your Flying Geese to use here
