#### **3 YARD QUILT**


This is a great class to take if you're a beginner, but you have a bit of experience either with our learn-to classes or beginner level quilts you've done on your own.

### **SUMMER RAG QUILT**

Living in Canada, we have become accustomed to our rag quilts being made with flannels. In this class, Louise is turning this idea on its head and doing a light summer rag quilt with quilting cotton. This version of rag quilt is used much more by our neighbors to the south, and it gives you a wider range of fabrics to choose from. Louise is suggesting you use 10" pre-cut squares (also known as

layer cakes) to eliminate the need to cut your yardage into squares and making the process even easier. You will be given the tried-and-true methods of creating beautiful but simple rag quilts. You will leave this class with the knowledge and ability to put together basic rag quilts in various sizes to fit a lap, a couch, or bed.


