JELLY ROLL LOVE RUG - Single Heart

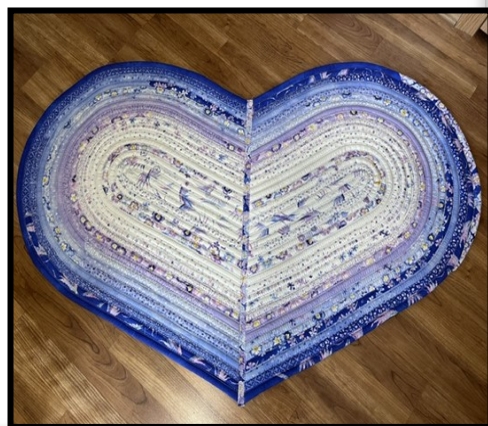

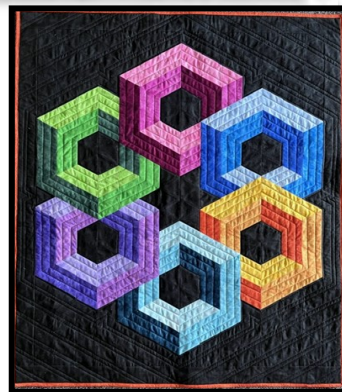
FIREFLY WALL HANGING \$90

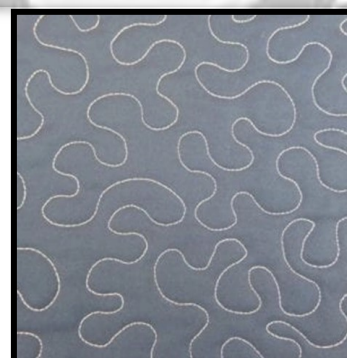
INTRO TO FREE MOTION QUILTING \$80
