




Quilting 102:

More Basics

Quilting 102 - Syllabus/Supply List

Welcome to Quilting 102! We are so excited to continue on this quilting journey with you. In this series of classes we will review some of the techniques that you learned in Quilting 101, and will be introducing new techniques as well. Here are some of the things that you will be learning:

- Reviewing Half Square Triangles and Introducing Combination Units
- Introducing Flying Geese
- Log Cabin Block
- Dresden Block
- Paper piecing (Pineapple Block)
- Applique



We will be making 2 each of 5 different block designs that will measure 12" finished (12 1/2" unfinished) and adding some fun borders. Finished quilt size is about 56" x 68" after borders.

Fabric requirements:

Background for blocks (White)	1 1/4 yard
Background for setting blocks (White)	1 1/4 yard
Fabric 1: for setting blocks (Dark Green)	3/4 yard
Fabric 2: for setting blocks and border	1 3/4 yard
Assorted fabrics ranging from lights to darks.	(6) 1/4 yard cuts or FQ, (2) 1/2 yard cuts (Med Green & Lt Blue)
Backing	3 2/3 yards
Binding	1/2 yard

Tools: *These are newly introduced rulers.
