

# Abracadabra!

Get ready to turn simple blocks into *quilting magic*! In this four-part series, we'll explore the world of disappearing blocks—9-patch, 4-patch, hourglass, and pinwheel. With a few clever cuts and twists, you'll learn how to transform basic units into stunning new designs. It's creative, it's playful, and it's the perfect way to level up your quilting skills while having a blast. Abra-ca-dab-ra... let's make some blocks disappear!

Supplies: Sewing Machine in working order, basic sewing kit including your favorite tools, cutters and rulers.

Fabric Requirements for each project:

**Disappearing Nine Patch: Makes a small table topper or runner.**

You can use any size fabric, or as many squares as you would like. Just make sure they are in multiples of 9.

(36) 5" squares (A charm pack would work well for this!)

Border 1: (1" finished) -  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard

Border 2: (2" finished) -  $\frac{1}{3}$  yard

**Disappearing 4-Patch**

You can use any size fabric, or as many squares as you would like. Just make sure they are in multiples of 4 (2 darks and 2 lights for each 4 patch).

**Disappearing Hourglass and Disappearing Pinwheel begin with Half Square Triangles (HST).**

You can use any size fabric, or as many HST's as you would like. Just make sure they are in multiples of 4 and made up of contrasting colors.

If you would like to participate in all of the classes and want to use best economic practices, may we recommend a 10" square pack, with matching background and coordinating fabric.

Background or light color for blocks 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  yards.

Border 1 and sashing - 2 yards

Border 2 - 2 yards
