<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Sewing machine with a 1/4" foot, walking foot for quilting (optional, compensating foot)</li> <li>* Iron &amp; Ironing surface</li> <li>* Rotary Cutter &amp; Mat</li> <li>* Scissors and/or Thread snips</li> <li>* Removable Marking pens/chalk</li> <li>* Stiletto</li> <li>* Turning Tool</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Wonder Clips</li> <li>* Bodkin</li> <li>* Pins</li> <li>* Basting tape</li> <li>* Washable Glue Stick</li> <li>* Quilting Ruler with a 45 degree angle</li> <li>* Circle Templates</li> <li>* Template Material</li> </ul>

### For this bag: Flipping Out Pattern

	Modified
<b>Main Fabric</b>	1/2 yard
<b>Coordinating Fabric</b>	1/2 yard
<b>Soft and Stable</b>	1/2 yard package or 15" x 24" scrap
<b>Fusible Interfacing</b>	1/2 yard
<b>Mesh Fabric</b>	9" x 24"
<b>Zippers</b>	30" and 1 pull
<b>Hardware</b>	Optional decorative ribbon
<b>Fold-over elastic</b>	3/4 yard
